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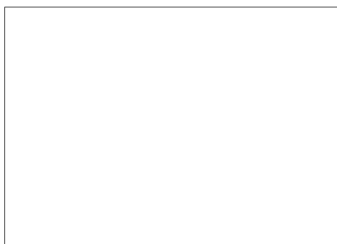

THE SUPPORT AREA, WHICH IS DIRECTLY WEST OF THE POSSIBLE LAUNCH SITE, CONTAINS THREE PROBABLE HOUSING BUILDINGS AND EIGHT SUPPORT BUILDINGS.

THE CONFIGURATION OF THIS SITE, PARTICULARLY OF THE TUNNEL-SERVED FIRING POSITIONS, IS SIMILAR TO THAT OF TA-CHIN TAO SAM SITE ([Redacted])

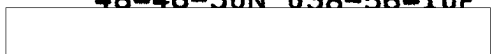
