PARKING FACILITIES -- PARKING FACILITIES CONSIST OF A PARALLEL TAXIWAY, ONE DISPERSAL TAXIWAY EXTENDING 2.6 NM SSW OF THE RP TO A PROBABLE U/G AIRCRAFT STORAGE AREA, TWO END-CONNECTING AND TWO CROSSOVER LINKS, THREE PARKING APRONS, TWO ALERT APRONS, 30 HARDSTANDS (17 REVETTED), AND ONE FIRING-IN-BUTT.
