PARKING FACILITIES -- THEY CONSIST OF A PARALLEL TAXIWAY, TWO END-CONNECTING, TWO CROSSOVER, AND THREE ACCESS TAXIWAYS, TWO ALERT APRONS, A PARKING APRON, A MAINTENANCE APRON, 17 REVETTED HARDSTANDS, AND ONE FIRING-IN BUTT.

SUPPORT FACILITIES -- ALL WEST OF THE RP, THEY INCLUDE ONE CONTROL TOWER/OPERATIONS BUILDING, ONE WEATHER STATION, THREE BARRACKS, TWO HANGARS, THREE WORKSHOPS, FIVE ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, A MESSHALL, AN AIR WARNING MOUND, AND 15 SUPPORT BUILDINGS.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND BARRACKS FACILITIES -- 2 NM WSW OF THE RP, THEY CONSIST OF 14 BARRACKS, FOUR ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, FOUR MESSHALLS, A PARACHUTE SHOP, NINE STORAGE BUILDINGS, ONE AUDITORIUM, AND 13 SUPPORT BUILDINGS. A PROBABLE PILOT TRAINING SCHOOL IS 4 NM SSW OF THE RP AND CONSISTS OF TEN BARRACKS, SIX CLASSROOM-TYPE BUILDINGS, ONE MESSHALL, SIX SUPPORT BUILDINGS, ONE HEAT/STEAM PLANT, TWO SMALL POL STORAGE TANKS, A WATER TOWER, AND A PARADE GROUND. THE PARADE GROUND USUALLY HAS AIRCRAFT PARKED ON IT.

AMMUNITION FACILITIES -- ABOUT 1.5 NM SW OF THE RP, THE FACILITY CONSISTS OF ONE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, FOUR SUPPORT BUILDINGS, AND A LARGE C-SHAPED REVETMENT WITH AN AMMUNITION STORAGE BUILDING.

POL FACILITIES -- THE AIRFIELD HAS TWO POL AREAS. AREA A IS SEPARATELY TARGETED AS TANG-KUAN-TUN PETROLEUM PRODUCTS STORAGE [REDACTED], 1.7 NM SOUTH OF THE RP. THE ROAD-AND RAIL-SERVED FACILITY CONTAINS A PUMPHOUSE, AN ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, A STORAGE BUILDING, A SUPPORT BUILDING, FOUR VERTICAL TANKS PUG, AND 24 HORIZONTAL TANKS PUG. AREA B, 2,300 FEET SSW OF THE RP, IS ROAD SERVED AND CONTAINS TWO ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, TWO SUPPORT BUILDINGS, A PUMPHOUSE, TWO VERTICAL TANKS PUG, AND 17 HORIZONTAL TANKS (TEN PUG).
