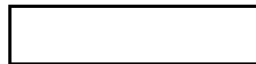

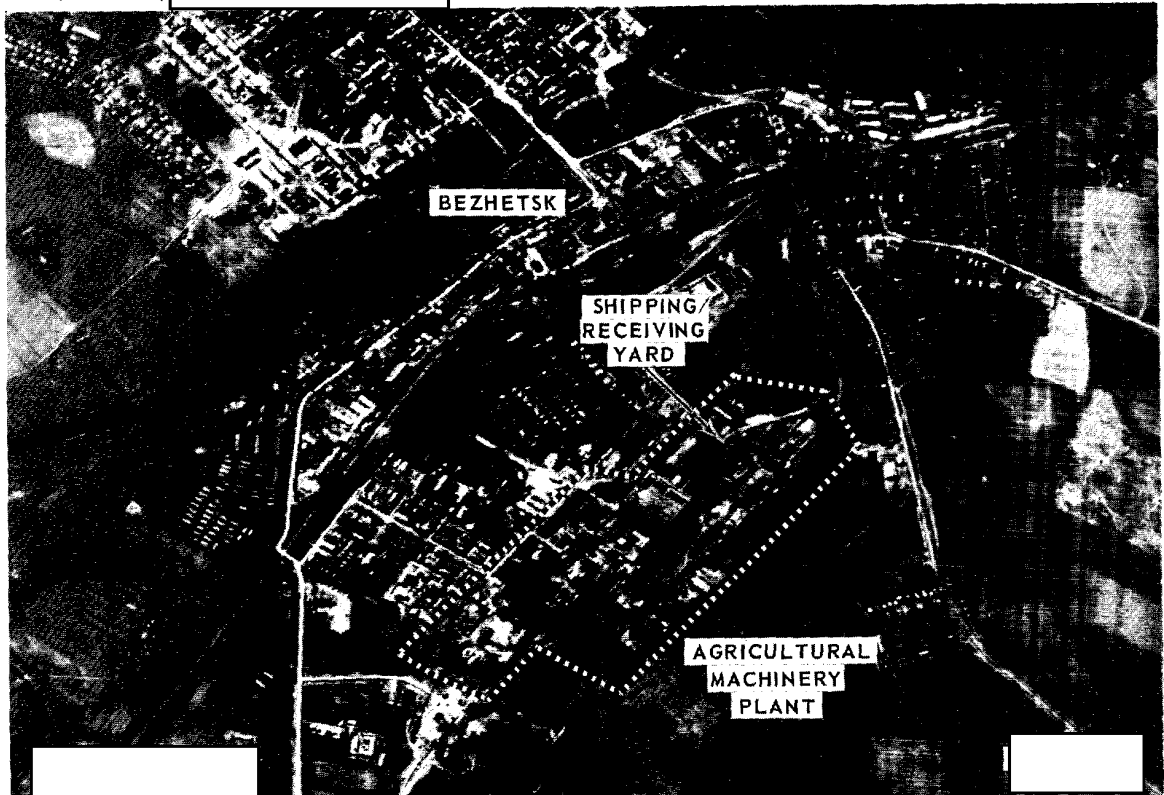

[REDACTED] a plant in Bezhetsk as the producer of cruise missile transporters. 1/ This is an apparent reference to the Bezhetsk Agricultural Machinery Plant, which has been covered by [REDACTED] photography of only fair interpretability and [REDACTED]

The plant is located on the northern outskirts of the town and covers approximately 100 acres. It has one large fabrication-type building approximately 300 by 300 feet and 2 large engineering-type buildings approximately 350 by 150 feet and 400 by 100 feet. There are approximately 20 minor buildings. A rail-served shipping and receiving yard is located at the west end of the plant.
