A new tactical surface-to-surface missile (SSM) support facility has been identified 3 nm SE of Sambor, USSR. It contains an [Redacted] [Redacted] 2 drive-through, earth-covered, arch-roofed missile storage buildings, 1 vehicle storage building, and 3 support buildings. The facility is secured by a single fence. The site is isolated in a densely wooded area, as are most of the newer tactical SSM support facilities such as Vladimir-Volinskiy. 1/ The older tactical SSM support facilities are located within previously established ammunition depots.

The Sambor site can be negated in [Redacted] 2/ and construction was seen in an early stage on [Redacted] 3/

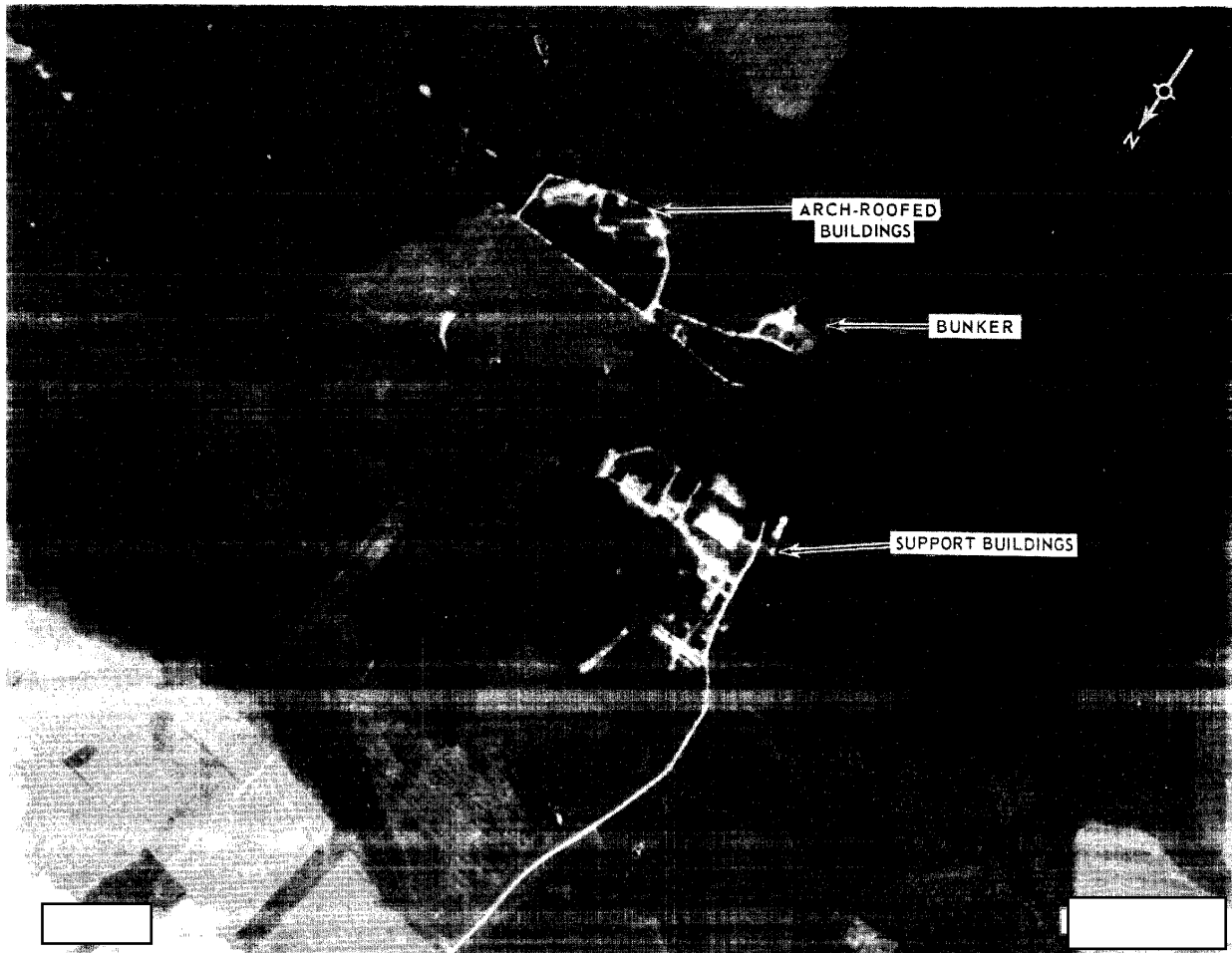
