SEARCH FOR COASTAL DEFENSE CRUISE MISSILE SITES POLAND, RUMANIA, AND BULGARIA
Collateral information suggests that coastal defense cruise missiles have been introduced into the East European Satellites in mid or late 1963. In line with this information a search was initiated in Poland, Rumania, 25X1 and Bulgaria using photography acquired since mid-1963.
No new cruise missile sites were discovered during a search of the areas in the countries listed below.
Poland
The following areas were searched on clear, good quality photography1
a. Entire Hel peninsula area from approximately 54-36N 18-48E Northwest to 54-49N 18-21E.
b. Ustka area 54-35N 16-50E . 25X1
c. Kolzbrzeg area 54-07N 15-35E
Rumania
The area from Constanta to Mangalia was searched utilizing photog5X1 raphy of with varying degrees of quality and cloud cover.
Bulgaria 25X1
The search areas below were observed on photography of ranging from poor to good quality with varying amounts of cloud cover.
