

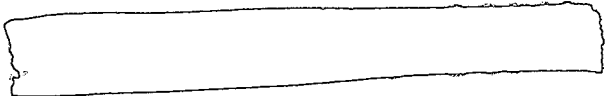

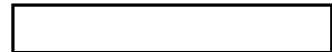

KEY TO ANNOTATIONS

1. Unidentified vessel under construction (LOA approx 440'). Very flat topside appearance and beam (approx 65') suggest this vessel may be a river ferry.
2. Possible river cargo barge under construction (visible LOA approx 225').
3. Unidentified surface vessel (LOA approx 320').
4. Probable stack-aft vessel (LOA approx 390').
5. Unidentified vessel (LOA approx 260').
6. Unidentified vessel (LOA approx 320').

7. Possible ZEYA Class YSRN (LOA approx 240'). Receipt of the first small format photography of a ZEYA Class sighted in the Pacific occurred subsequent to the publication of the previous PIR readout of this yard (CIA/PIR-67104). Although the film quality on [redacted] precludes a detailed proportional analysis of this vessel the unique small forward superstructure area and the depressed center area equate to the best [redacted] imagery of the ZEYA Class unit observed at Severodvinsk (see annotation 1, CIA/PIR-67165). A continuing analysis of previous [redacted] missions over Gorkiy has revealed that a ZEYA Class YSRN has been located at this yard as early as [redacted]. Analysis of [redacted] [redacted] revealed that a ZEYA Class proportionally identical to the unit seen at Severodvinsk Shipyard 402, Severodvinsk, USSR (64-35N 039-50E) [redacted] was located in the water just NW of the launching basin. (See upper two views, Figure 2.) Analysis of [redacted] over Severodvinsk [redacted] also revealed the presence of a ZEYA Class by the Yagry Island Nuclear Submarine Special Support Facility thereby confirming the presence of at least two of these units in the European USSR. A possible ZEYA Class YSRN has been observed at Gorkiy berthed in its present position alongside a fitting-out pier ([redacted]) (See lower two views, Figure 2.)

9. Unidentified surface vessel (LOA approx 330').
10. Two empty transporter docks (LOA of each approx 430').
