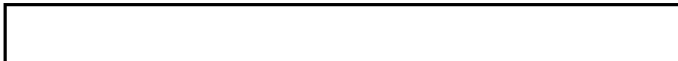

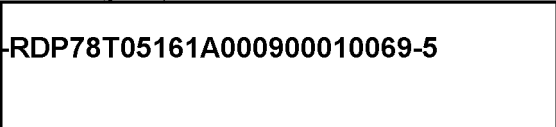

A search of all portions of the Sino-Soviet/Sino-Mongolian Border covered on [redacted] was accomplished in accordance with the prescribed procedure of analysing each new mission in an attempt to determine possible changes in the type or level of military activity within 150 nm of the Sino-Soviet/Sino-Mongolian Border (significant items within 300 nm may also be included).

Figure 1 graphically illustrates the portions of the border areas that were covered by photography (cloud cover and other limitations on photographic quality are not depicted).

[redacted] do not reveal any significant changes in billeting or storage facilities at these installations since photography of [redacted]. A significant amount of unidentified equipment is parked throughout the Berezovskiy installation. Training activity on the tracked vehicle driver training courses and on the firing ranges at both installations appears to have increased since photography of [redacted].

ALEKSEYEVKA AREA TRACK ACTIVITY, USSR

Approximately 5 nm SSW of Alekseyevka is an area containing vehicle track activity (medium snow cover on the ground). The area of activity is on the Soviet side of the border adjacent to a stream that constitutes the border. The type of activity (military or civil) and its significance cannot be determined from this mission.

FERGANA BARRACKS & TRAINING AREA, USSR

40 19N-071 43E

Activity within the barracks area and on the firing ranges at this installation appear to be at medium level. A slight increase in training activity is noted on the firing ranges since previous photographic coverage.
