Installation names are derived from the DIA Bombing Encyclopedia (May

Each installation is examined for physical changes to the facilities, changes in the level of activity, and the identification of vehicles and equipment.

All changes in facilities and vehicle/equipment type and/or count are referenced to the most recent detailed report on the installation. In cases where reports do not exist, the changes are referenced to the most recent complete mission readout.

The sequence of installation listing within this report is by country, type of target, military district or region, and alphabetically by installation name. A report of this type will follow each Mission.








PROBABLE HEAVY SELF PROPELLED PONTONS M1965




KLOOGA ARMY BARRACKS W AL 1

HEAVY SELF PROPELLED PONTON M1965




CENTER SECTION
