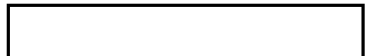

PREFACE

A search was made of photographic coverage of the Hao-shih, China area (24 00N-115 21E) to locate any military construction activity and to date any construction observed.

Construction of a probable military complex was observed in the general vicinity of Hao-shih which has, for the purpose of this report, been divided into four separate areas (See Figure 2). These areas are described functionally within this report; however, a more detailed analysis was limited by a lack of large scale photography.

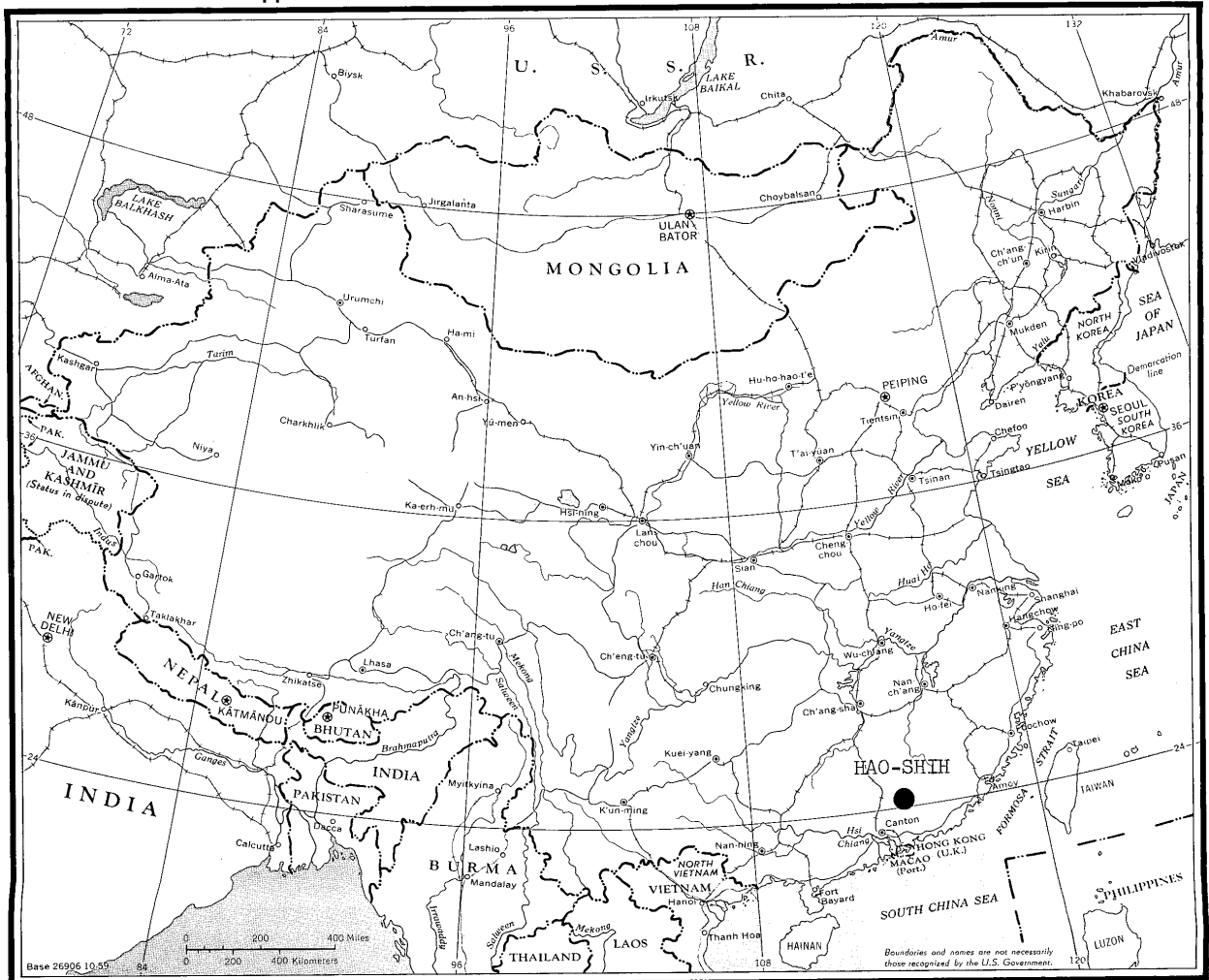

FUNCTIONAL ANALYSISArea 1 (See Figure 2)

- 2 C-shaped probable administration buildings
- 1 Probable administration building
- 2 Possible administration buildings
- 61 Small probable barracks
- 19 Small possible barracks
- 1 T-shaped auditorium/gymnasium
- 9 Possible vehicle sheds
- 1 Possible vehicle maintenance building
- 12 Possible storage buildings
- 94 Support buildings

Several small unit-sized training areas are noted in this area containing trenching activity and possible weapons positions.

Area 2 (See Figure 2)

- 1 C-shaped probable administration building
- 1 Possible administration building
- 9 Small probable barracks
- 61 Small possible barracks
- 1 T-shaped auditorium/gymnasium
- 14 Probable explosives storage buildings
- 8 Probable storage buildings
- 70 Support buildings

Only limited training activity is noted in this area.

Area 3 (See Figure 2)

- 2 C-shaped probable administration buildings
- 66 Possible barracks
- 1 T-shaped auditorium/gymnasium
- 10 Possible vehicle sheds
- 7 Probable explosives storage buildings
- 18 Possible storage buildings
- 68 Support buildings

Area 4 (See Figure 2)

- 1 Possible administration building
- 4 Possible barracks
- 6 Possible storage buildings
- 35 Support buildings

SUMMARY

Photography [ ] provides the best coverage for dating construction in the vicinity of Hao-shih. Construction in all sections of Area 1 appeared to have been completed or nearly completed. No construction and only a few clearings were observed in Area 2. Construction activity was observed in most of the presently occupied sections of Area 3 and appeared to have been completed in some. No activity was observed in Area 4. Construction activity (approximately half-completed) was observed in Areas 2 and 4 on [ ] coverage.

Examination of villages near Hao-shih reveals little change in activity on [ ] coverage.

Interesting similarities between this area and the military complex at Chiu-weng-yuan (CIA/PIR-67199) are their overall possible small unit patterns and dispersal of functional areas.

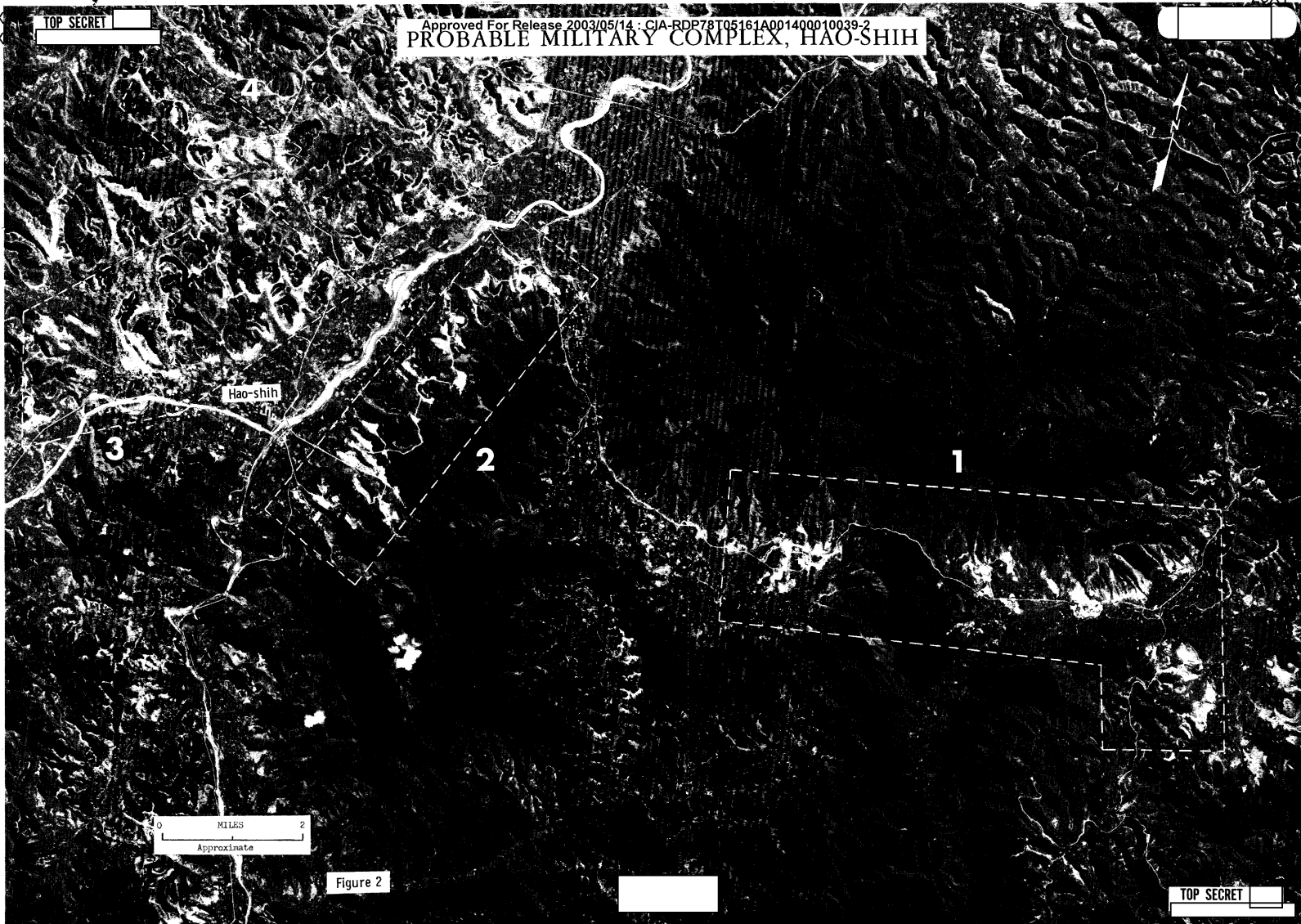
