CELLULOSE AND CHEMICAL COMBINE

AMURSK, USSR

The Amursk Cellulose and Chemical Combine (50-13N 136-53E) is located at Amursk, USSR, 19 nautical miles south-southwest of Komsomolsk on the left bank of the Amur River. This plant was reported to be under construction here in 1958, 1/ and was scheduled to be in full operation by 1965. 2/

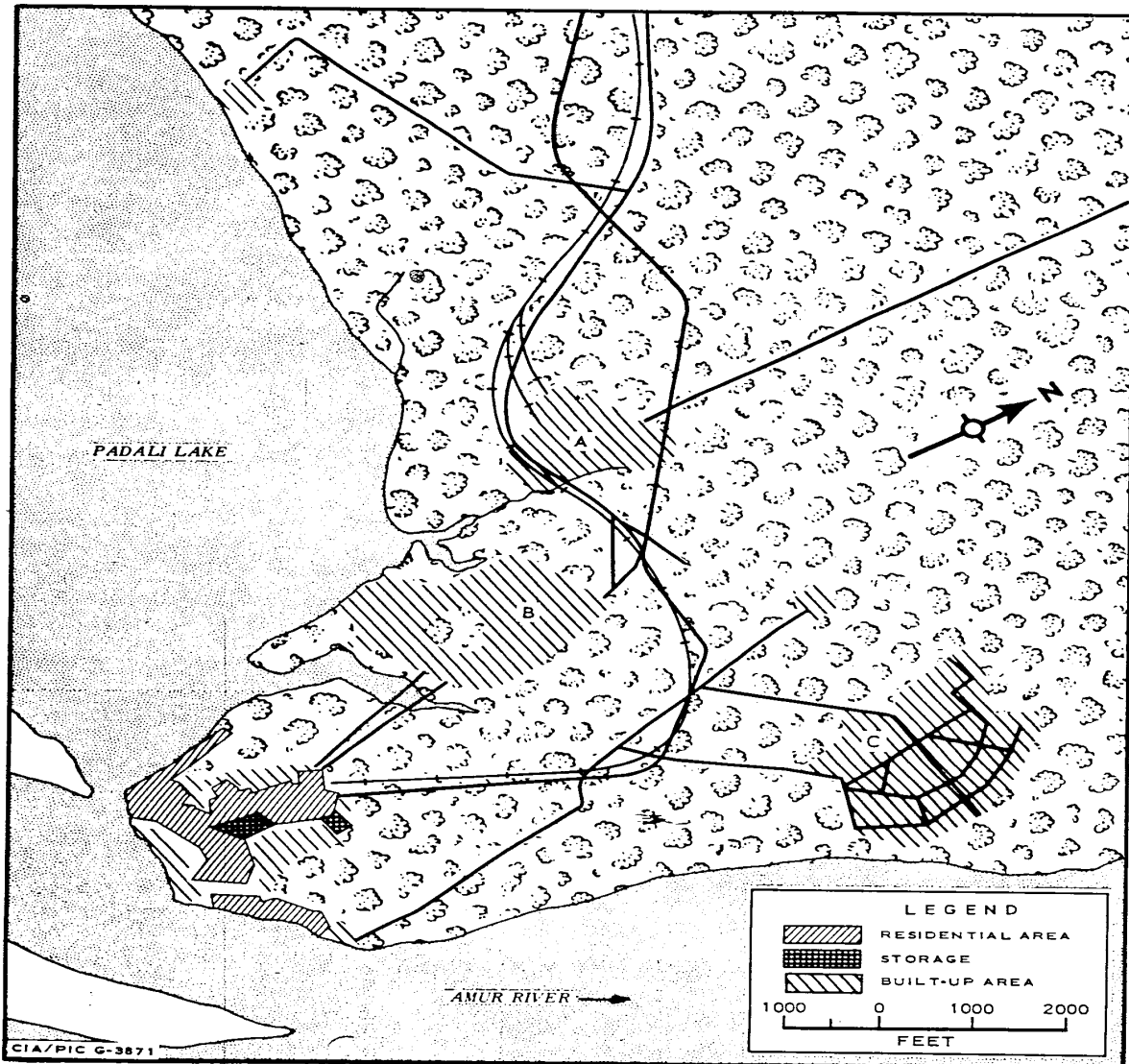


FIGURE 2. AREA OF CELLULOSE AND CHEMICAL COMBINE, AMURSK. Portions shown in red are from [redacted]

TALENT photography [redacted] shows only residential areas, two small storage areas, clearings, and a partially finished road to Amursk, connecting with the highway to Komsomolsk (see Figure 2).

KEYHOLE photography of [redacted] shows a further expansion of the areas seen earlier, plus three new areas (A, B, and C). No identification can be made of the activity here, except that the street pattern of one area (C) is typically residential and another area (A) has two entering rail spurs.

A new rail line has been reported constructed 3/ and its alignment appears to parallel the aforementioned partially finished vehicular road (see Figure 2).

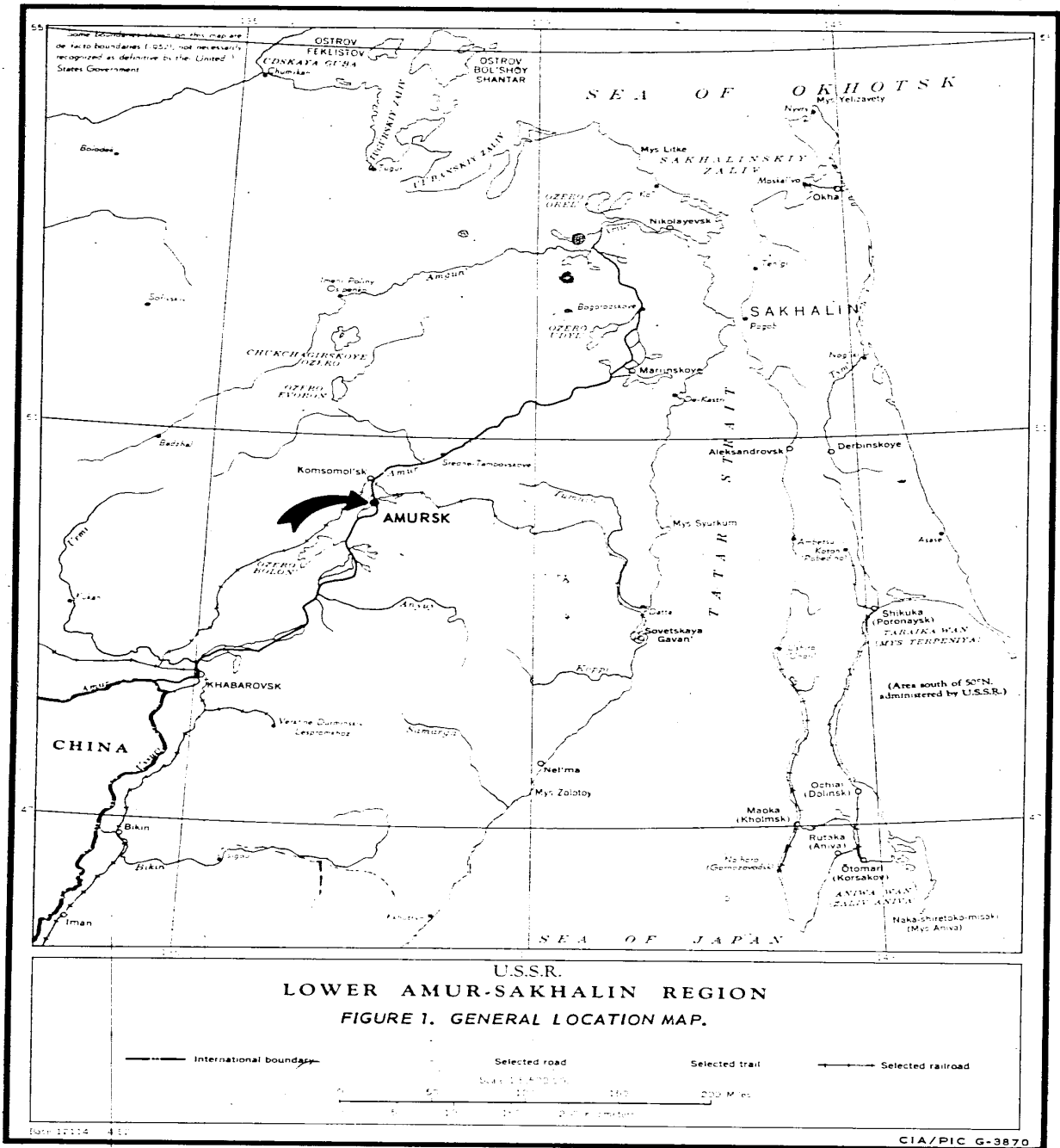
