SUMMARY: This ammunition storage area is located 2 miles east-southeast of the Slonim classification yard, approximately midway between the Slonim-Baranovichi railroad and the primary Slonim-Baranovichi road. It occupies a rectangular-fenced area of 8 acres, served by an access road, connecting with the Slonim-Baranovichi highway. The installation contains one ammunition storage building 160' x 40' (6,400 square feet of floor space), one ammunition storage building 100' x 40' (4,000 square feet), and two support buildings (3,600 square feet).

Comment: This ammunition storage facility is probably associated with the Slonim East Barracks and maneuver area, which is located adjacent to the storage area.

**SUMMARY:** This ammunition storage area is located 1 mile south of SLONIM, on the east side of the secondary dirt road from SLONIM southwest to BRAKOVO. It occupies a fenced rectangular area of 15 acres, served by an access road, connecting with the Slonim-Brakovo road. The installation contains four gable-roofed ammunition storage buildings, 100' x 50' average, (18,900 square feet of floor space), one building probably used for administration and temporary storage of ammunition 200' x 55', and one other storage building 115' x 55'. All the buildings in this area are directly accessible to a good network of internal roads.

**COMMENT:** It is probable this ammunition storage area is associated with the Slonim Army Barracks, which is located less than a mile to the north.

SUMMARY: This storage area is located in the northeastern edge of SLONIM, adjacent to the west end of the Slonim classification yard. It occupies an irregular area of 6 acres, served by city streets and a rail spur from the Volkovsk-Berzanevichi rail line. The installation contains four large gable-roofed warehouses (54,100 square feet of floor space), with the following dimensions: One - 299' x 75' (with a fire wall), one - 190' x 75', one - 185' x 75', and one - 95' x 45'.

SUMMARY: This vehicle repair and storage area is located 1 mile south of SLONIM, on the east side of the secondary dirt road from Slonim southwest to Brakovo. It occupies a fenced irregular area of 35 acres, served by the Slonim-Brakovo road. The installation contains the following buildings: 10 vehicle maintenance and storage buildings (51,500 square feet of floor space), ranging in size from 65' x 30' to 175' x 65'; 11 vehicle storage sheds (77,000 square feet), ranging in size from 120' x 30' to 210' x 40'; and 12 miscellaneous support buildings, ranging in size from 35' x 25' to 60' x 40'.

At time of photography, there were approximately 100 vehicles parked in the installation.

Comment: It is probable that this installation is associated with the Slonim Army Barracks, which is located 1 mile to the north.

SUMMARY: This ammunition storage area is located 2 miles northeast of the center of SLUTSK, on the north side of the Slutsk-Solor highway, near the junction of the single-track railway east of Slutsk with the highway. It occupies a fenced rectangular area of 8 acres, served by an access road connecting with an unimproved road between a small village and the Slutsk Army Barracks. The installation contains four ammunition storage buildings 65' [REDACTED] (8,300 square feet of floor space).

Comment: It is probable that this storage area is directly associated with the Slutsk Army Barracks, which is located several hundred yards to the northwest. The road connecting the two areas appears to be well traveled.

SUMMARY: This POL storage area is located at the south edge of SMOLEVICHI, on the west side of the road from SMOLEVICHI to STUDENKA. It occupies a fenced rectangular area of 3 acres, served by an access road, connecting with the Smolevichi-Studenka road. POL storage facilities consist of four vertical tanks [redacted] in diameter and two horizontal tanks [redacted] in diameter and [redacted] long.

SUMMARY: This storage area is located in the eastern edge of STOLBTSY, adjacent to the south end of the classification yard. It occupies a fence-enclosed area of 10 acres. The area is served by a city street and is readily accessible to the rail yard. The installation contains five gable-roofed warehouses (50,300 square feet of floor space), with the following dimensions: one -170' x 35', two -140' x 35', one -160' x 65', one -55' x 30'.

SUMMARY: This installation is located in the north central sector of VITEBSK, on the south side of the Dvina river near the point where it forms a bend. The area is bounded on the east by Malaya Il'inskaya Street, and on the south by Lyarkova Street. It occupies a walled area of 18 acres, served by a rail spur from the Vitebsk Classification Yard and by city streets. The installation contains the following major facilities: (1) - grain elevator and grain storage silos [REDACTED], (2) - sectional probable processing building, connected to grain elevator by covered conveyor with a multistoried 155' x 55' section, and a 1-storied 290' x 35' extension, (3)-multistoried probable processing building 60' x 35', (4)-1-storied probable storage building 175' x 45', which adjoins item three, (5)- probable processing and storage building with a multistoried 70' x 40' and a 1-storied 285' x 90' sections, (6) - 2-storied administration building (22,000 square feet of floor space), (7) - two buildings probably used for billeting (8,700 square feet).

In addition to the buildings there are two possible tanks and one elevator water tank.

SUMMARY: This POL storage area is located 3 miles south-southwest of VITEBSK, adjacent to the south side of the Vitebsk-Beshenkovichi road at a point where it crosses the Vitebsk-Orsha rail line. It occupies a partially fenced rectangular area of 20 acres. (the area appeared to be still under construction at time of photography). served by a rail spur off the Vitebsk-Orsha rail line and by the Vitebsk-Beshenkovichi road. The installation contains 12 vertical POL storage tanks and 18 associated buildings (35,600 square feet of floor space).

Diameter of POL storage tanks: one - [redacted] feet in diameter, three - [redacted] feet in diameter, one - 20 feet in diameter, two - [redacted] feet in diameter, two - size undetermined, and three - [redacted] feet in diameter.

SUMMARY:

Two adjacent storage areas are located in north central sector of VITEBSK, on the north side of Katenicheskaya street and on the west side of Kanatnaya Street, designated for the purpose of this report as Areas 1 and 2.

Area 1 occupies a fence enclosed irregular area of seven acres, served by two rail spurs and by city streets. It contains 11 buildings: 8 warehouses (92,000 square feet floor space) ranging in size from 145' x 50' to 370' x 45' all directly accessible to the two rail spurs, and 3 buildings use undetermined (6,500 square feet).

Area 2 occupies a fenced irregular area of 3 acres served by city streets. It contains three major storage buildings ranging in size from 120' x 55' to 210' x 50', totalling 25,700 square feet floor space.

SUMMARY: This installation is located 3 miles south-southwest of the center of VITEBSK, on the east side of the Vitebsk-Orsha rail line. It occupies a rectangular walled area of 30 acres, served by a spur from the Vitebsk-Orsha rail line, which splits into a double siding within the installation, and by an access road, connecting with the Vitebsk-Sloboda road. Major storage facilities consist of four 470' x 85' warehouses directly accessible to the rail sidings, (159,800 square feet of floor space). The installation contains eight miscellaneous support buildings.

SUMMARY: This storage area is located on the southern outskirts of VOLKOVYSK, adjacent to the north side of the Volkovysk-Slonim rail line, 2 miles east of the point where this rail line forms a junction with the Volkovysk-Zancuensk rail line. It occupies a fenced irregular area of 8 acres, served by an access road, connecting with a city street, and by a rail spur from the Volkovysk-Slonim rail line. The installation contains three gable-roofed warehouses, 56,800 square feet of floor space.
