

reveals a SCR-270 type radar site located one nm north of Tao-lin. The site contains one trailer-mounted antenna, 2 barracks, 2 support buildings, a guard/security structure, and one truck. The antenna was not rotating at the time. The site may be in a late stage of construction.

A separate, secured area located 0.5 nm NW of the site contains three small buildings and a guard/security structure.




FIGURE 1. EARLY-WARNING RADAR SITE NEAR TAO-LIN
