- b. The installation where the missiles were photographed is located on a hilltop at 69-23-52N 33-29-30E (map reference: ACIC 1:50,000, photo mosaic 0051-18/97M). There was no activity at this location in the photograph of the coverage of the installation revealed no recognizable changes from the table TALENT photography. This installation does not appear similar to any SA-3 site identified in the USSR, to date, on KEYHOLE photography, however it is definitely the location where the missiles were observed on the ground photography. The attached line drawing indicates measurements between unidentified items on this hilltop as imaged on KEYHOLE photography.
