




FIGURE 1. LOCATION MAP.




FIGURE 5. MOSCOW SAM SITE COT-




FIGURE 6. MOSCOW SAM SITE COS








FIGURE 8. MOSCOW SAM SITE E02-




FIGURE 9. MOSCOW SAM SITE E03-1, 2




FIGURE 10. MOSCOW SAM SITE E04-1, 25




FIGURE 11. MOSCOW SAM SITE E05-1




FIGURE 12. MOSCOW SAM SITE E06-1




FIGURE 14. MOSCOW SAM SITE E08-
