1. This memorandum is in response to your requirement dated 2 March 1964 requesting the confirmation and/or identification from ground photography of a previously reported Coaxial Repeater Station between Kvetnov and Svaty Kric, Czechoslovakia at UTM coordinates WQ 425897 (49-33-50N 015-35-30E).

2. A comparison of this installation with the photographs of the Telecommunications Cable Repeater Stations portrayed in the Collection Guide "Telecommunications of the Sino-Soviet Bloc" (CIA/RRG,CG, 61-4) dated May 1961 reveals that none of the features of this installation resemble these Cable Repeater Stations.
