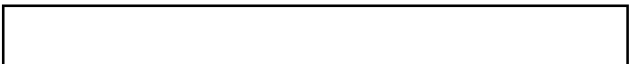

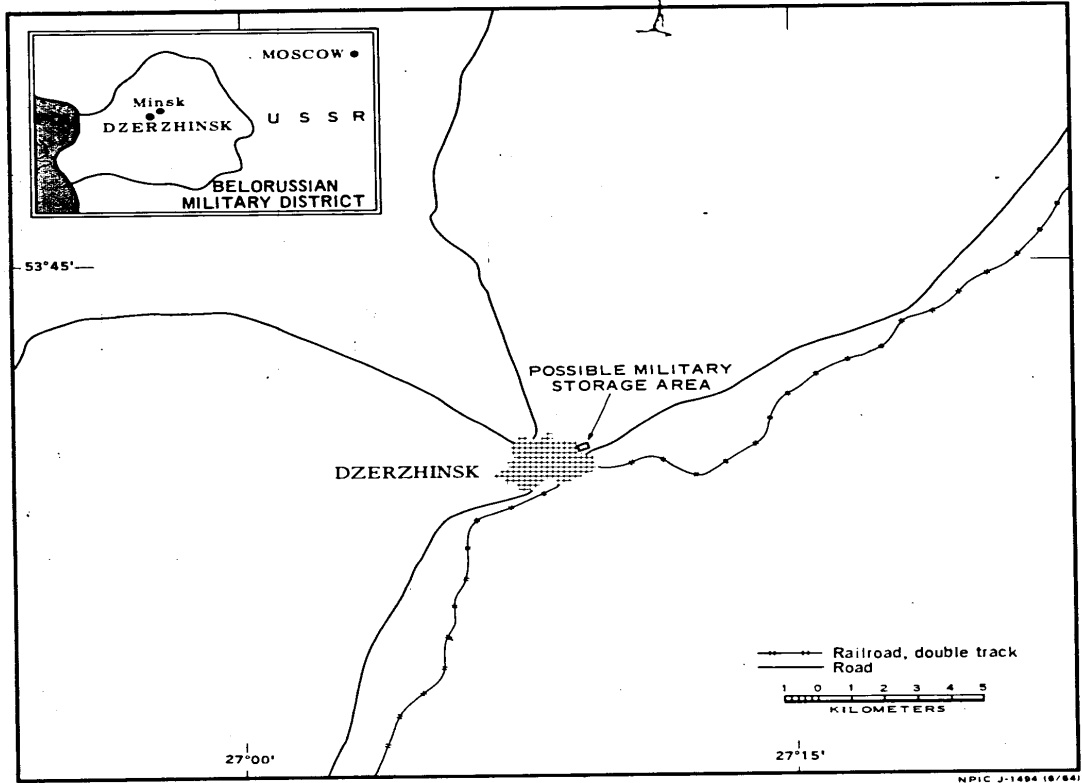


FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF POSSIBLE MILITARY STORAGE AREA, DZERZHINSK.

SUMMARY

A possible military storage area (Figure 1) is located on the northeast edge of Dzerzhinsk (53-41N 027-08E). This installation is identified in the Bombing Encyclopedia as Dzerzhinsk Army Barracks Northeast [redacted] AL-1). No barracks are identified in this installation. The area is served by the primary Dzerzhinsk-Minsk highway. Dzerzhinsk Army Barracks Southeast is located 6.6 kilometers (km) southeast.

Railroad Service

The area is not directly rail served; however, the main Minsk-Baranovichi rail line serves Dzerzhinsk.

Road Service

The Dzerzhinsk-Minsk highway passes on the south edge of the installation.

General Storage Area

Area E, secured, contains 12 storage buildings and 19 support buildings, all apparently occupied. Five of the storage buildings and two of the support buildings have been added [redacted]

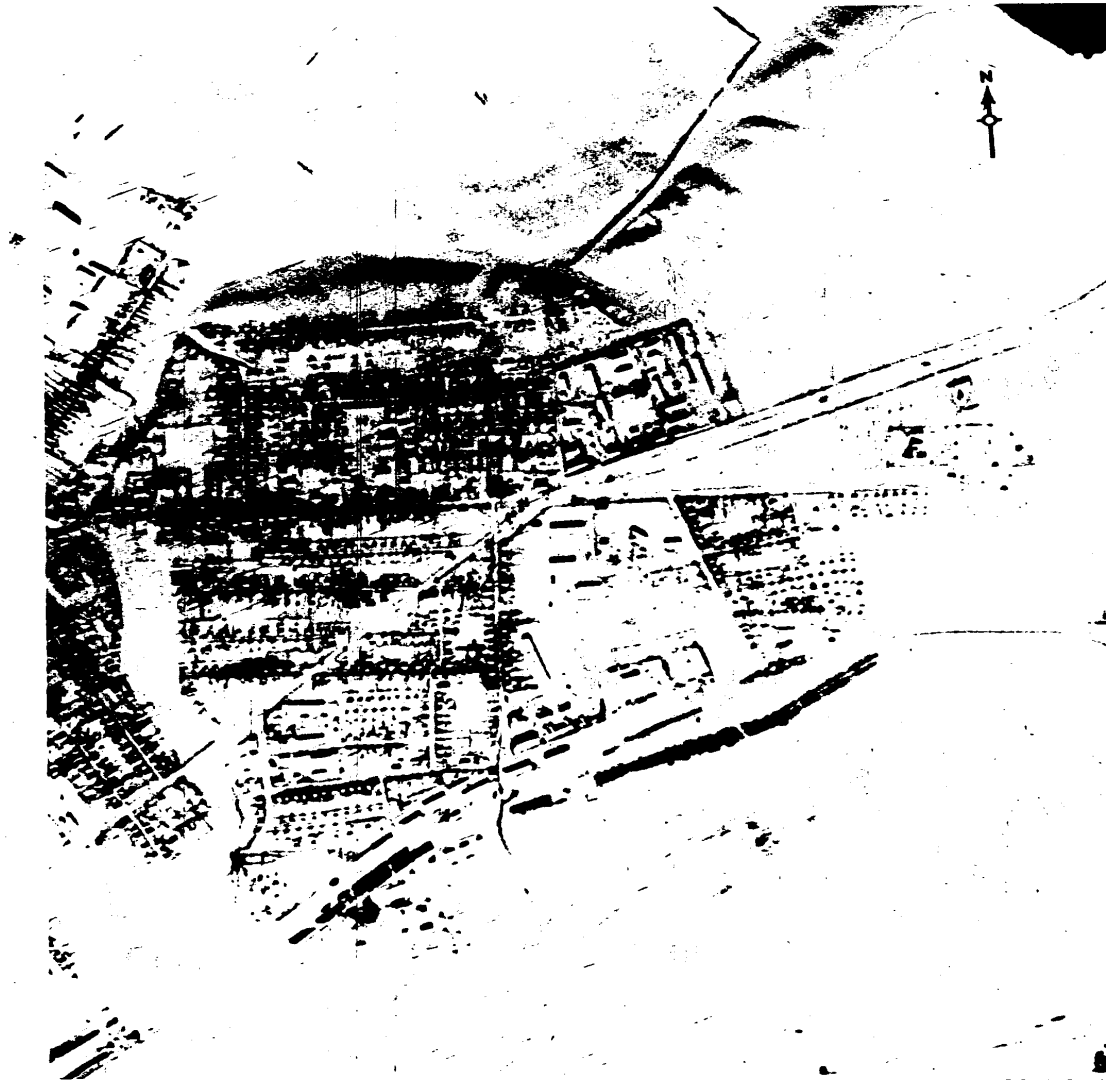


FIGURE 2. POSSIBLE MILITARY STORAGE AREA, DZERZHINSK, USSR, [REDACTED]

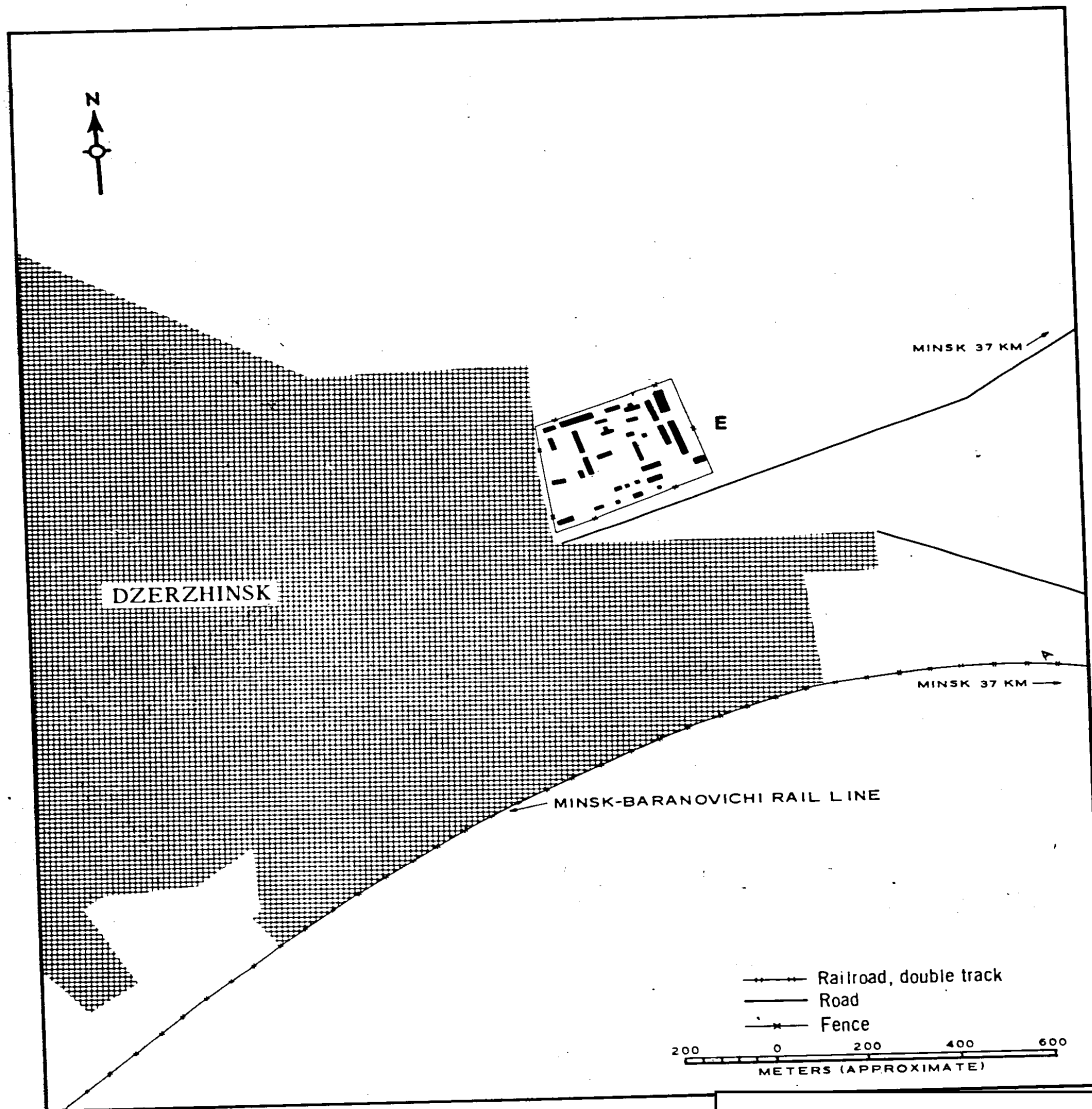


FIGURE 3. POSSIBLE MILITARY STORAGE AREA, DZERZHINSK. Sketch compiled
