5. SEVASTOPOL NAVAL BASE:

A. [REDACTED] REPORTED 1 W-CLASS SS, 1 PROBABLE SS, AND 9 POSSIBLE SS. OTHER MAJOR VESSELS OBSERVED WERE 6 CL, 2 KILDIN-CLASS DDG, 5 DE, AND 19 DD/DE TYPES.

B. THIS MISSION REVEALS 2 POSSIBLE J-CLASS SSG, 5 UNIDENTIFIED SS, AND 1 POSSIBLE M. MOD.- V CLASS SS IN SEVASTOPOL NAVAL BASE AND SHIPYARD. ONE SUBMARINE (PROBABLE W/R-CLASS) AND ONE POSSIBLE SS WERE REPORTED IN KILENBALOCHNAYA BAY IMMEDIATELY TO THE EAST OF THE SHIPYARD. ALSO REPORTED WERE 5 CL, 15 DD, AND 5 DE.

6. BALAKLAVA SUBMARINE BASE:

A. [REDACTED] REPORTED 5 MEDIUM SUBMARINES.

B. THIS MISSION REVEALS 4 SUBMARINES (PROBABLE W/R-CLASS SS), 4 UNIDENTIFIED SUBMARINES AND 1 PROBABLE ATREK-CLASS ASL.

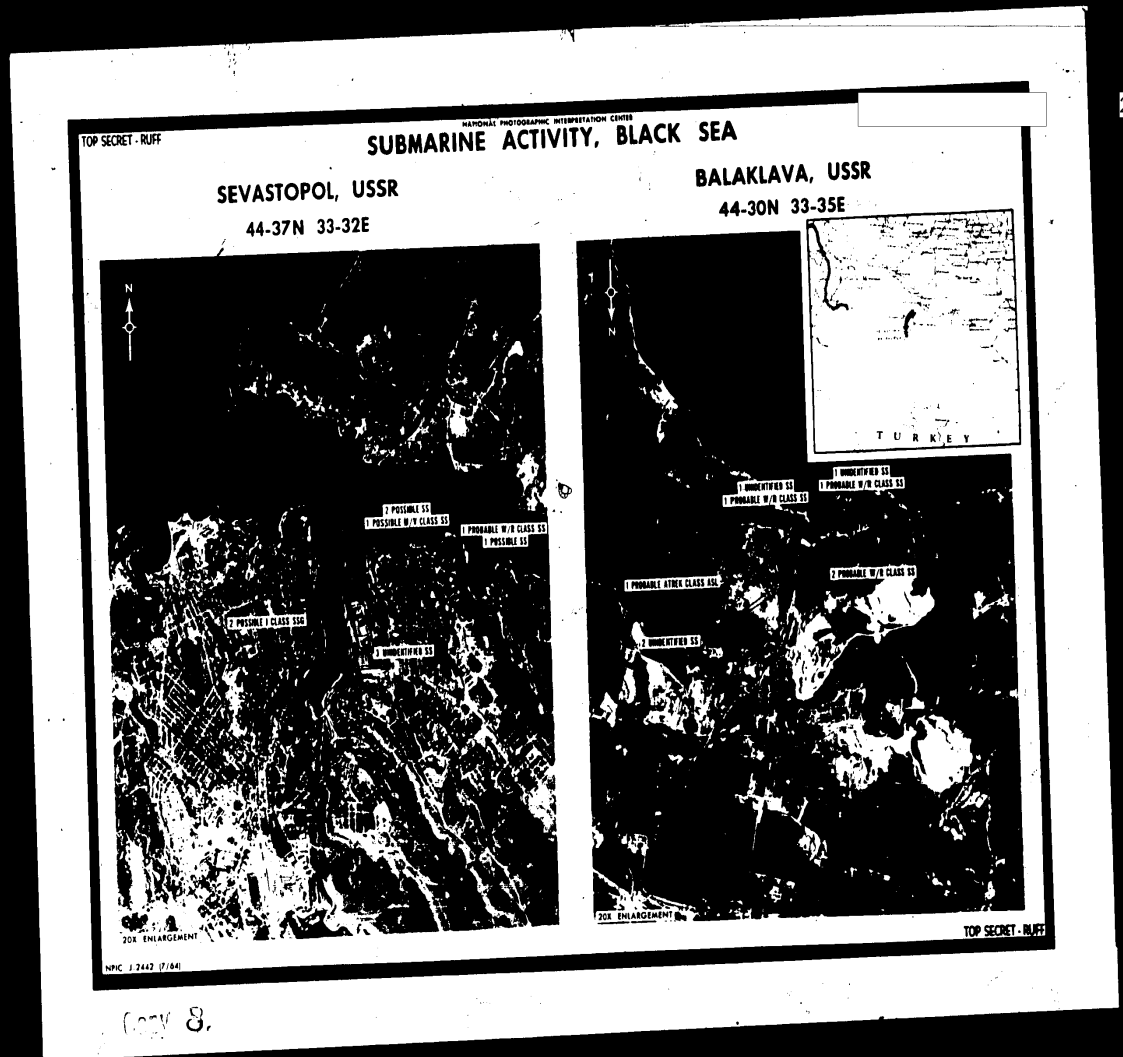
