



FIGURE 2. UZHGOROG AMMUNITION DEPOT DRAVCE, USSR.

A medium-sized ammunition depot is located 5 kilometers (km) east of Uzhgorod, immediately east of the village of Goryanu (Figure 1). The installation (Figures 2 and 3) consists of 15 revetted storage buildings, five troop barracks, 11 small administrative buildings, several small miscellaneous buildings, and a

motor pool. This installation remained relatively unchanged from

#### DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

#### Railroad Service

A new double-track rail spur from Uzhgorod apparently ends in an area of new construction adjacent to the depot.

### Road Service

The installation is served by an all-weather, hard-surface road.

# Administration and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains five permanent multistory 150- by 35-foot barracks and 11 permanent 50by 25-foot administrative buildings.

#### General Storage Areas

Area E1 contains three permanent buildings, and Area E2 contains one.

#### Ammunition Storage Area

Area F contains 15 permanent reveted 100- by 35-foot explosives storage buildings, one permanent 200- by 50-foot building, and five small miscellaneous buildings varying in size.

## Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains a 825- by 600-foot motor pool, two 150- by 50-foot flat-roofed vehicle storage sheds, and one 100, by 35-foot vehicle maintenance building.
