## SUMMARY:

This preliminary study reports a nuclear weapons proving ground covering an area in excess of 360 square miles including at least 8 ground zeros, shot tower and instrumentation, auxilliary airfield, and limited support facilities; several major industrial complexes; I major airfield with a total of 5 bombers, 7 fighters, 10 transports and one helicopter. Intermittent cloud cover varying from scattered to heavy occurs throughout the mission.
