- 4- [Redacted] REVEALS A MILITARY CAMP IMMEDIATELY SOUTH OF LHASA ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE KYI CHHU (RIVER). THE AREA IS WALLED AND CONTAINS 26 BARRACKS, 8 ADMINISTRATION-TYPE BUILDINGS, 24 STORAGE-TYPE BUILDINGS, 5 MESS HALLS, ONE VEHICLE SHED, AND 16 ASSOCIATED BUILDINGS. TWENTY-TWO FA PIECES, 4 AAA GUNS, 35 CARGO TRUCKS AND 13 UTILITY TRUCKS ARE ALSO OBSERVED.

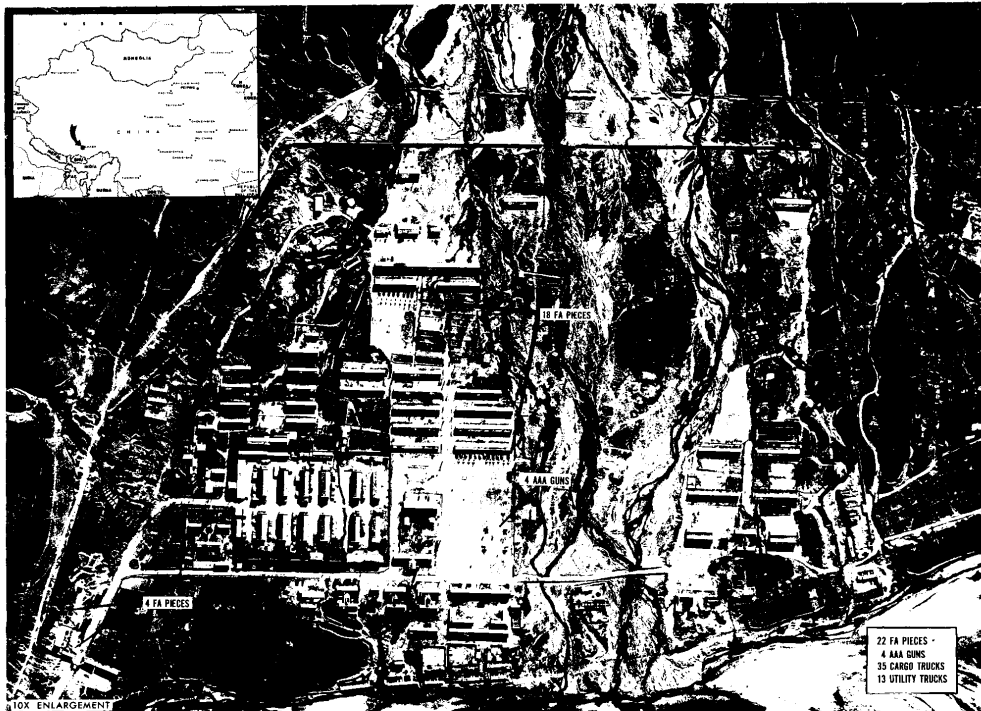
