BUREVESTNIK AIRFIELD

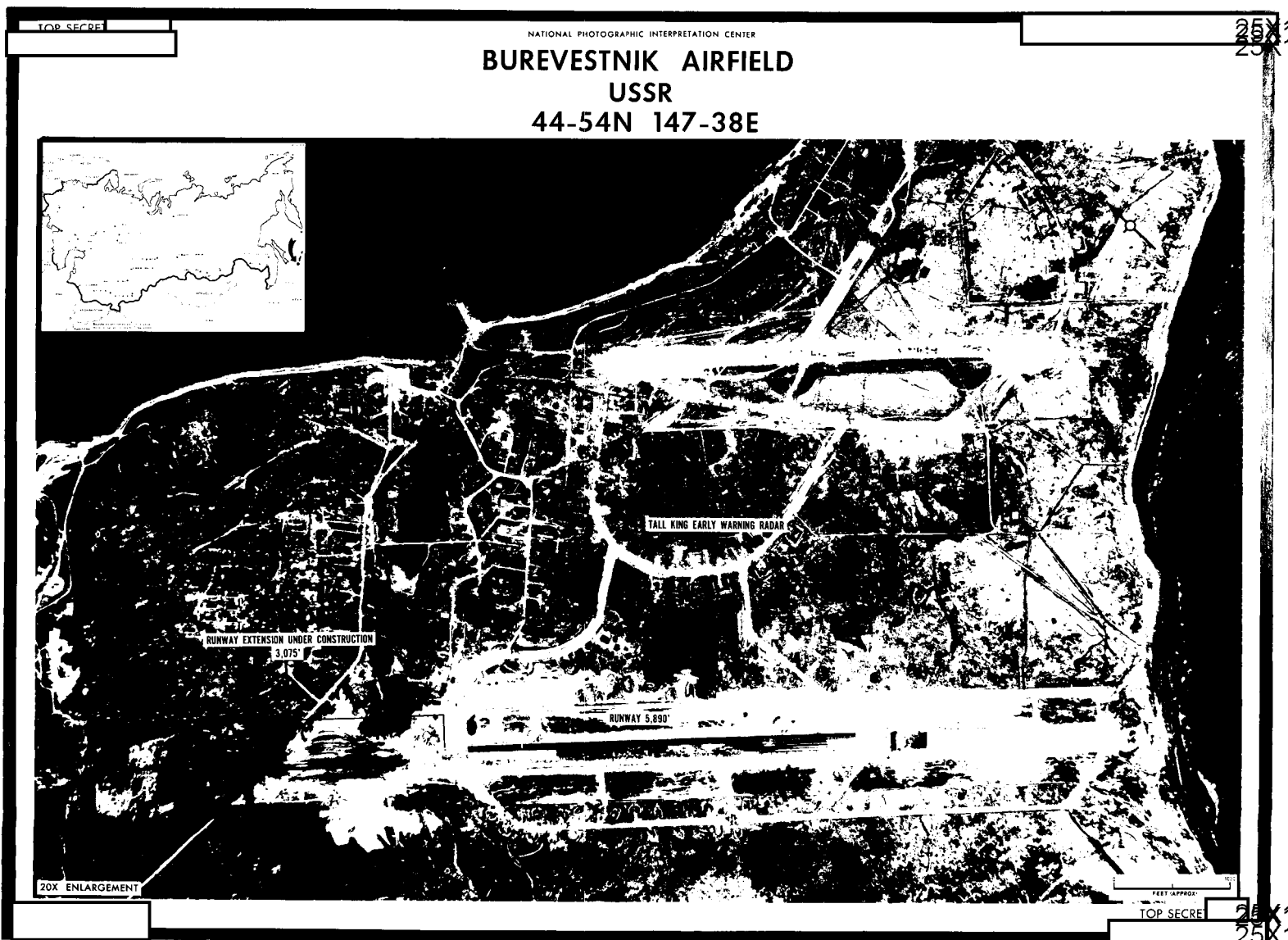
1. THIS WORLD WAR II AIRFIELD, THEN KNOWN AS TENNEI AIRFIELD, IS AMONG THE LARGEST AND MOST MODERN IN THE KURIL ISLANDS. IT IS LOCATED 120 MILES NORTH OF HOKKAIDO, JAPAN. AIRCRAFT COUNTS IN EXCESS OF 100 WERE COMMON HERE DURING THE PERIOD 1945-52.
2. [REDACTED] THE ONLY PREVIOUS SYSTEM PHOTOGRAPHY, REVEALED 41 FAGOT/FRESCO AIRCRAFT AT THE AIRFIELD. THE MAIN RUNWAY WAS 6,350 FEET LONG.

4. THIS MISSION REVEALS CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY AT THE NW END OF THE AIRFIELD. THE COMPLETED RUNWAY WILL BE 8,965 BY 160 FEET. A TALL KING RADAR SITE IS LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 3,000 FEET NE OF THE CENTER OF THE RUNWAY. AIRCRAFT OBSERVED INCLUDE 1 FAGOT, 1 CAB, AND 1 HOUND.
