THE VERTICAL TEST STAND WAS REPORTED TO BE IN THE

LATE STAGES OF CONSTRUCTION, WHILE THE HORIZONTAL

TEST POSITIONS WERE COMPLETE. ALL 3 TEST SITES ARE

SITUATED IN SPECIALLY PREPARED HILLSIDE CUTTINGS A
LONG THE WESTERN SHORE OF LAKE VYSOKINSKOYE.

THE MAIN PART OF THE FACILITY WAS CONSTRUCTED
BETWEEN 1956 AND SEP 1963. SINCE THEN THE AREA AT


