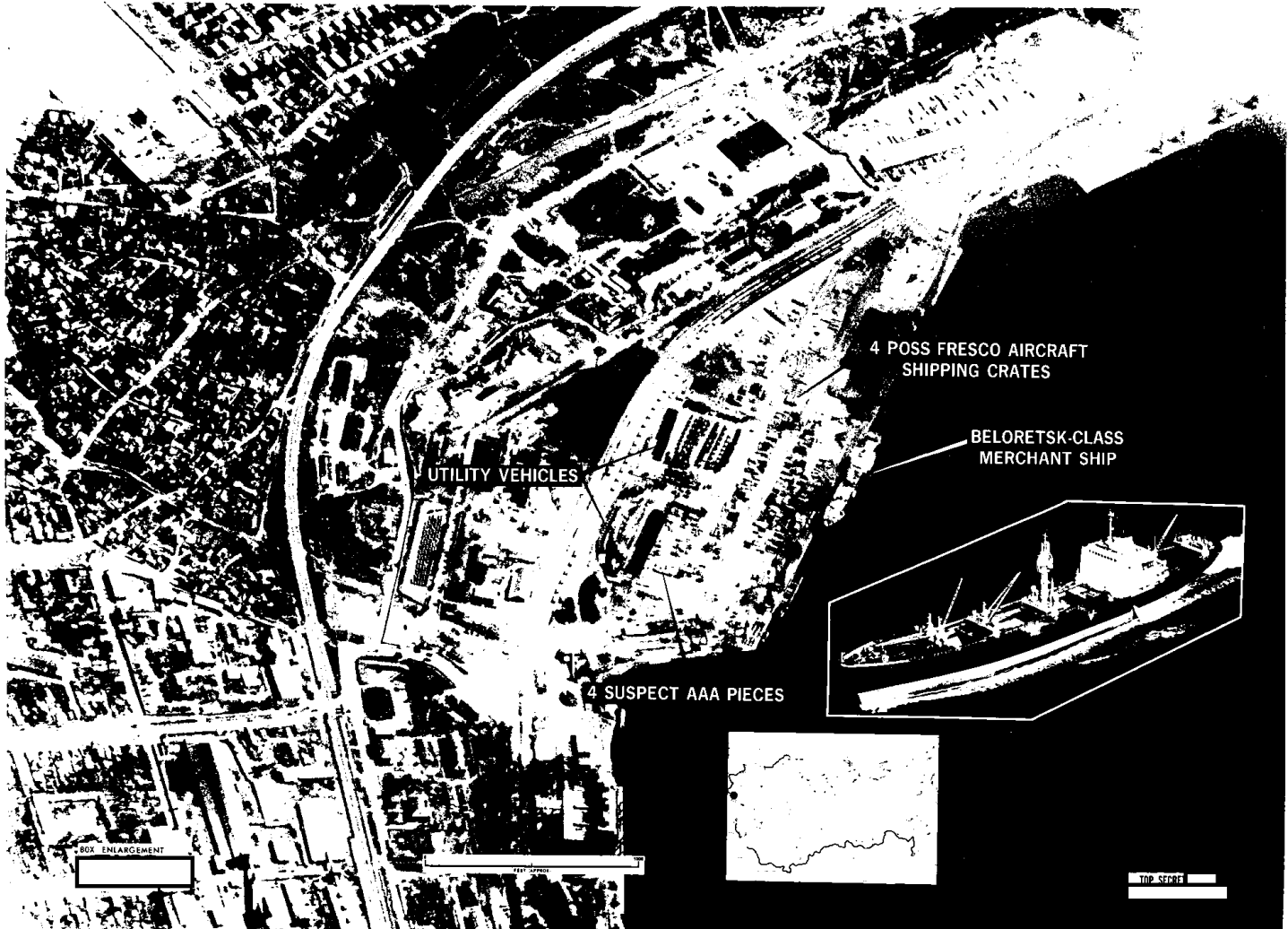

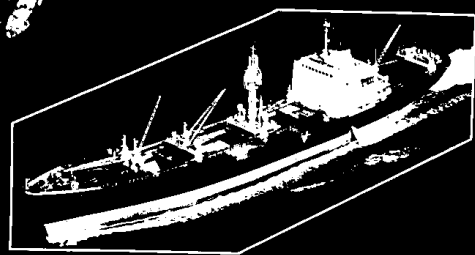


4 POSS FRESCO AIRCRAFT SHIPPING CRATES

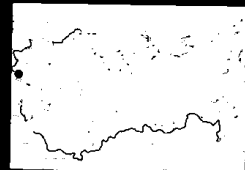
