1. SIGNIFICANCE: FIVE TYPE IIID SINGLE-SILO ICBM LAUNCH SITES ARE NEWLY IDENTIFIED AT THE KOZELSK ICBM COMPLEX.
  
2. REMARKS: THE KOZELSK ICBM COMPLEX IS ONE OF 9 COMPLEXES AT WHICH TYPE IIID SITES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED, AND IT IS ONE OF 8 IIID COMPLEXES AT WHICH EARLIER MODES OF ICBM DEPLOYMENT WERE PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED. THE OTHER 7 ARE THE DROVYANAYA, GLADKAYA, KOSTROMA, OLOVYANNAYA, PERM, SVOBODNYI, AND YEDROVO ICBM COMPLEXES. THESE 7 COMPLEXES ARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE SS-7 ICBM, WHEREAS KOZELSK IS THE FIRST SS-8 COMPLEX AT WHICH IIID DEPLOYMENT HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED. THE TATISHCHEVO ICBM COMPLEX IS THE ONLY IDENTIFIED COMPLEX WHICH CONTAINS ONLY IIID ICBM SITES. AT KOZELSK, THE LAUNCH SITES WHICH WERE IDENTIFIED PRIOR TO IIID DEPLOYMENT INCLUDE 3 TYPE

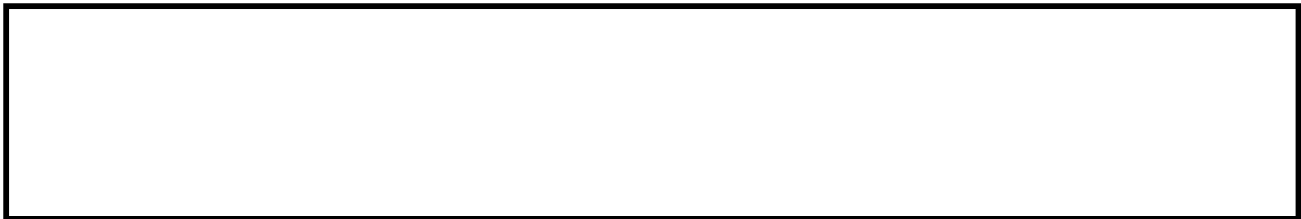

IIC (SOFT) SITES AND 2 TYPE IIIB (HARD) SITES  
(BOTH TYPES ARE ASSOCIATED BY GMAIC WITH THE  
SS-8 ICBM). IN ADDITION, A IIC SITE AND A IIIB  
SITE WERE ABANDONED WHILE IN THE EARLY STAGES  
OF CONSTRUCTION. (THE IIC SITE WAS ABANDONED  
AND WAS REPLACED BY THE IIIB SITE WHICH WAS THEN  
LATER ABANDONED.) TWO PROBABLE TYPE IIID SITES  
WERE IDENTIFIED PRIOR TO THIS MISSION.

7. SUBSEQUENT COVERAGE: COMPLEX -- 23 KH-4 AND 5 KH-7 MISSIONS.  
IIID DEPLOYMENT -- NONE.

8. DIMENSIONS/  
SPECIFICATIONS: INNER DIAMETER OF IIID SILO -- (APPROX) 25X1  
OUTER DIAMETER OF IIID SILO -- (APPROX)

9. MISSION READOUT: FIVE TYPE IIID LAUNCH SITES, SITES 9 THROUGH 13, ARE NEWLY IDENTIFIED. SITES 7, 10, AND 12 ARE IN THE MID-STAGES OF CONSTRUCTION; SITES 8, 9, AND 11 ARE IN THE EARLY STAGES; AND SITE 13 IS IN AN UNDETERMINED STAGE OF CONSTRUCTION. APPROXIMATE DISTANCES AND DIRECTIONS FROM THE COMPLEX SUPPORT FACILITY ARE AS FOLLOWS: SITE 9 - 13.5 NM SSW, SITE 10 - 11 NM SSW, SITE 11 - 5 NM SW, SITE 12 - 6 NM SOUTH, AND SITE 13 - 3.5 NM SOUTH.  
THE PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED PROBABLE SITES 7 AND 8 ARE NOW CONFIRMED, AND SITE 7 IS IDENTIFIED AS A PROBABLE CONTROL SITE.
