1. SIGNIFICANCE: SS-1 SCUD TACTICAL MISSILE EQUIPMENT IS NEWLY IDENTIFIED AT THIS FACILITY.

2. REMARKS: NPIC REPORT 163-64, MAR 64, REPORTED THIS INSTALLATION CONSTRUCTED BETWEEN [Redacted] [Redacted] IT CONTAINED 2 DRIVE-THROUGH BUILDINGS, 2 WAREHOUSES WITH SIDE ENTRANCES, AND 3 HANGERETTES. FIVE SHIPPING CRATES OBSERVED WERE COMPARABLE IN SIZE TO THOSE USED FOR KOMET (KENNEL) AS-1 MISSILES IN CUBA.

SUBSEQUENT NPIC REPORTS REVEALED INDICATIONS OF CRUISE MISSILE SYSTEM VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT (NPIC CABLE P-151, APR 66, [Redacted])

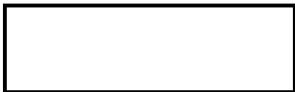

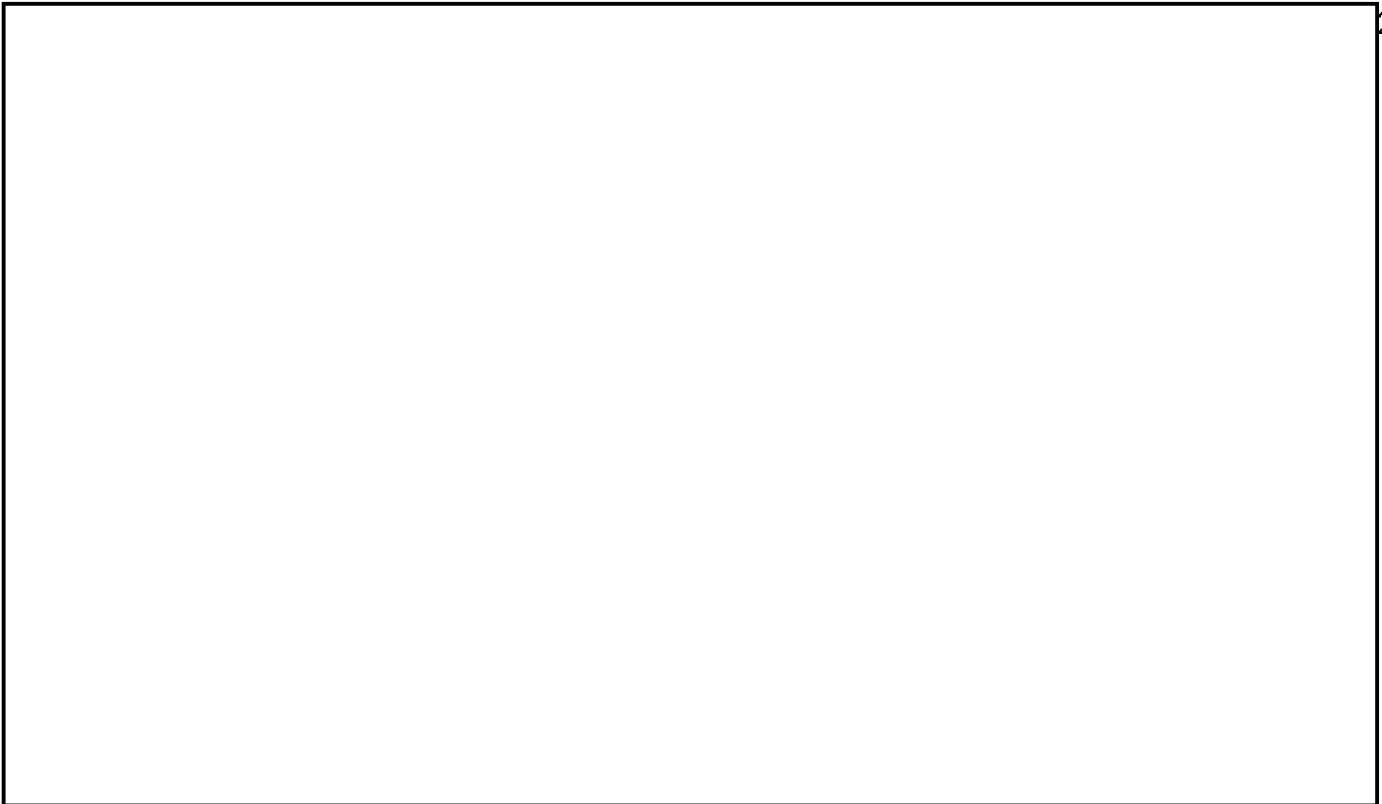

9. MISSION READOUT: SECURED FACILITY CONSISTS OF AN ADMINISTRATION AND BARRACKS AREA, A SUPPORT AREA, A PROBABLE MISSILE AND WARHEAD STORAGE AREA, AND A FUEL STORAGE AREA.

THE ADMINISTRATION AND BARRACKS AREA CONTAINS 5 BARRACKS, 1 ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, 3 SUPPORT BUILDINGS, AND AN ATHLETIC FIELD.

THE SUPPORT AREA IMMEDIATELY ESE OF THE ADMINISTRATION AND BARRACKS AREA CONTAINS 3 DRIVE-THROUGH MISSILE CHECKOUT BUILDINGS, 5 VEHICLE STORAGE BUILDINGS, 6 SUPPORT BUILDINGS, AND A HEATING PLANT.

THE PROBABLE MISSILE AND WARHEAD STORAGE AREA IS ADJACENT TO THE EAST EDGE OF THE SUPPORT AREA AND CONTAINS 2 LARGE EARTH-COVERED, ARCH-ROOFED PROBABLE MISSILE STORAGE BUILDINGS, 1 PROBABLE [redacted] STORAGE BUNKER, AND 2 STORAGE BUILDINGS.

[redacted] THE NEARLY SQUARE, EARTH-COVERED BUNKER HAS A LARGE ENTRANCE SERVED BY A CONCRETE ROAD AND HARDSTAND AND A SMALL PROBABLE PERSONNEL ENTRANCE ON THE SIDE OF THE BUNKER. A CLUSTER OF 4 SMALL VENTILATORS IN A TRAPEZOIDAL PATTERN AND A SMALL RAISED RECTANGULAR SECTION

ARE OBSERVED ON TOP OF THE BUNKER.

THE FUEL STORAGE AREA LOCATED NORTH OF THE ADMINISTRATION AND BARRACKS AREA CONTAINS 3 STORAGE/SUPPORT BUILDINGS, 13 HORIZONTAL FUEL STORAGE TANKS, AND 20 SMALL STORAGE CONTAINERS.

VEHICLES/PIECES OF EQUIPMENT INCLUDE 16 SS-1 SCUD MISSILE RESUPPLY TRANSPORT TRAILERS WITH TRUCK TRACTORS, 1 POSSIBLE MISSILE DOLLY, 3 PROBABLE AT-T, 50 CARGO TRUCKS, 24 VAN TRUCKS, 1 TRUCK-MOUNTED CRANE, AND 1 LOWBED TRAILER.

THE PRESENCE OF SS-1 SCUD TACTICAL MISSILE EQUIPMENT IN THE FACILITY AND THE PREVIOUS IDENTIFICATION OF EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH AN UNIDENTIFIED CRUISE MISSILE SYSTEM [Redacted] INDICATES THE FACILITY PROVIDES GENERAL SUPPORT AND STORAGE FOR GROUND FORCE TACTICAL SURFACE-TO-SURFACE MISSILES AND WARHEADS.

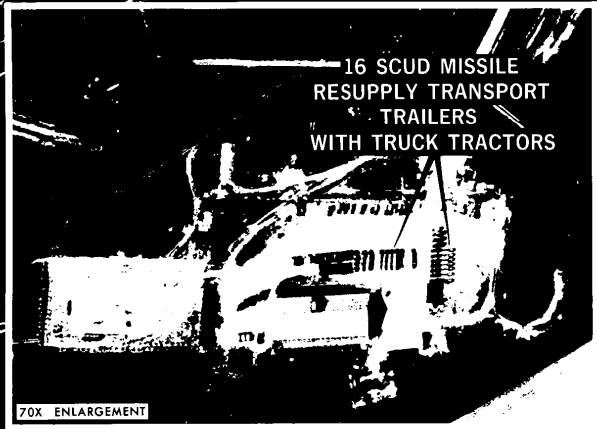
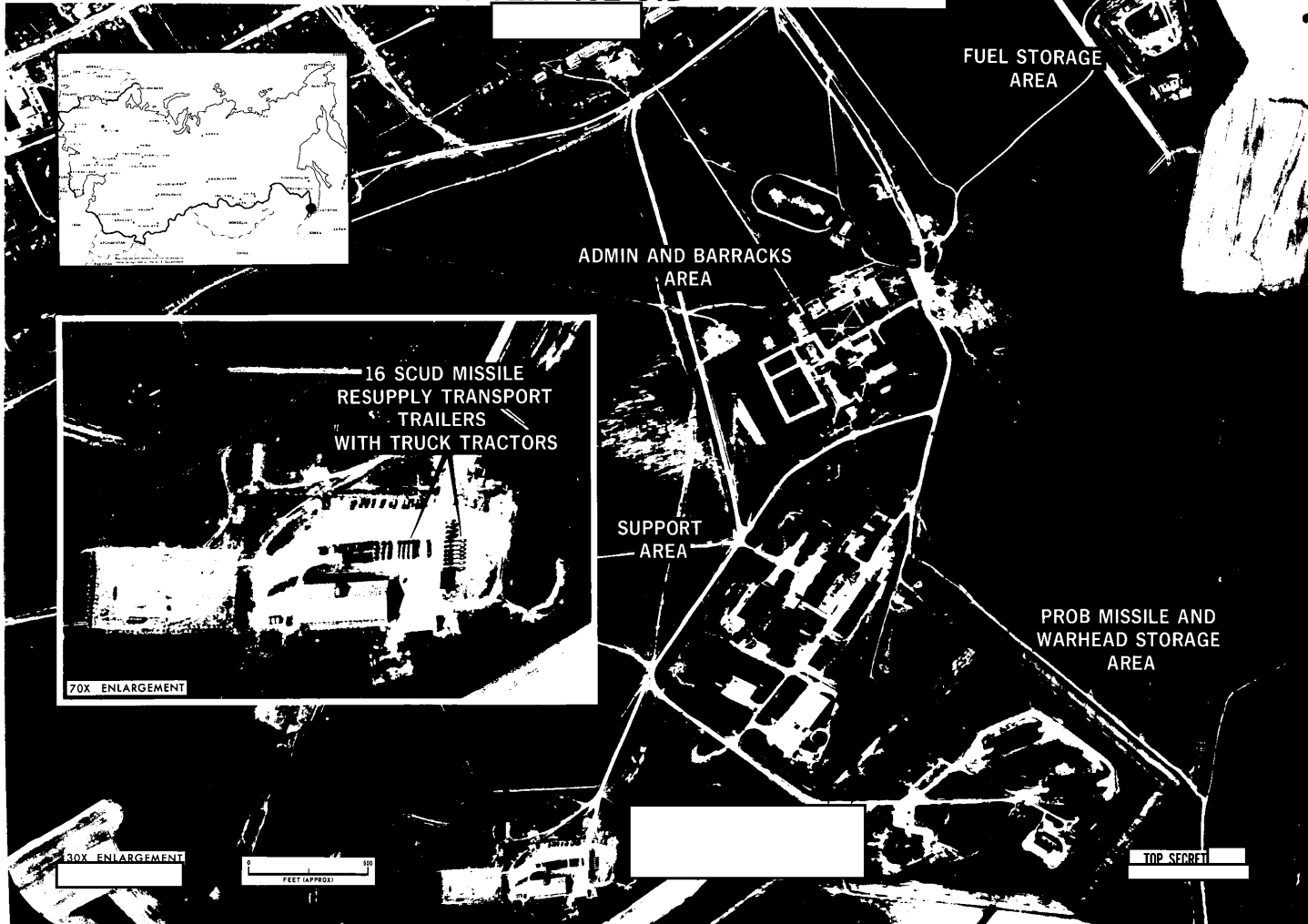
