- 1. SIGNIFICANCE: PROBABLE LONG RANGE SAMS ARE OBSERVED AT LAUNCH SITES 3 AND 4 AT LAUNCH COMPLEX "A".
- 2. LOCATION: 36 NM WNW OF SARY-SHAGAN
- 3. REMARKS: SITES 3 AND 4 ARE THE R&D FACILITIES FOR THE "TALLINN" TYPE PROBABLE LONG RANGE SAM LAUNCH COMPLEXES WHICH HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AT 27 LOCATIONS IN THE USSR. (THE 3 LENINGRAD COMPLEXES BRING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF COMPLEXES TO 30.)

9. MISSION READOUT: THERE ARE 8 PROBABLE LONG RANGE SAMs ON OR ADJACENT TO LAUNCH SITE 3. THIS NUMBER INCLUDES 2 PROBABLE MISSILE MOCKUPS PRESENT IN THE AREA JUST NORTH OF POSITION 3/3. THESE MISSILE MOCKUPS HAVE REAPPEARED, APPARENTLY IN AN EARLY STAGE OF ASSEMBLY, ON THE 2 PALLETS/CRADLES WHICH WERE OBSERVED TO BE UNOCCUPIED ON [Redacted] ONE PROBABLE LONG RANGE SAM IS OBSERVED AT LAUNCH SITE 4. INCREASE IN ACTIVITY IS EVIDENT AT LAUNCH SITE 4 BY THE REAPPEARANCE OF 4 ADDITIONAL LAUNCHERS SINCE [Redacted] IN THE MISSILE HANDLING AREA, 2 MISSILES CAN BE SEEN IN TANDEM POSITION CLOSE TO THE NORTH END OF THE EASTERMOST OF THE 2 PARALLEL, 215-FT LONG, ELEVATED RAIL-EQUIPPED STRUCTURES.

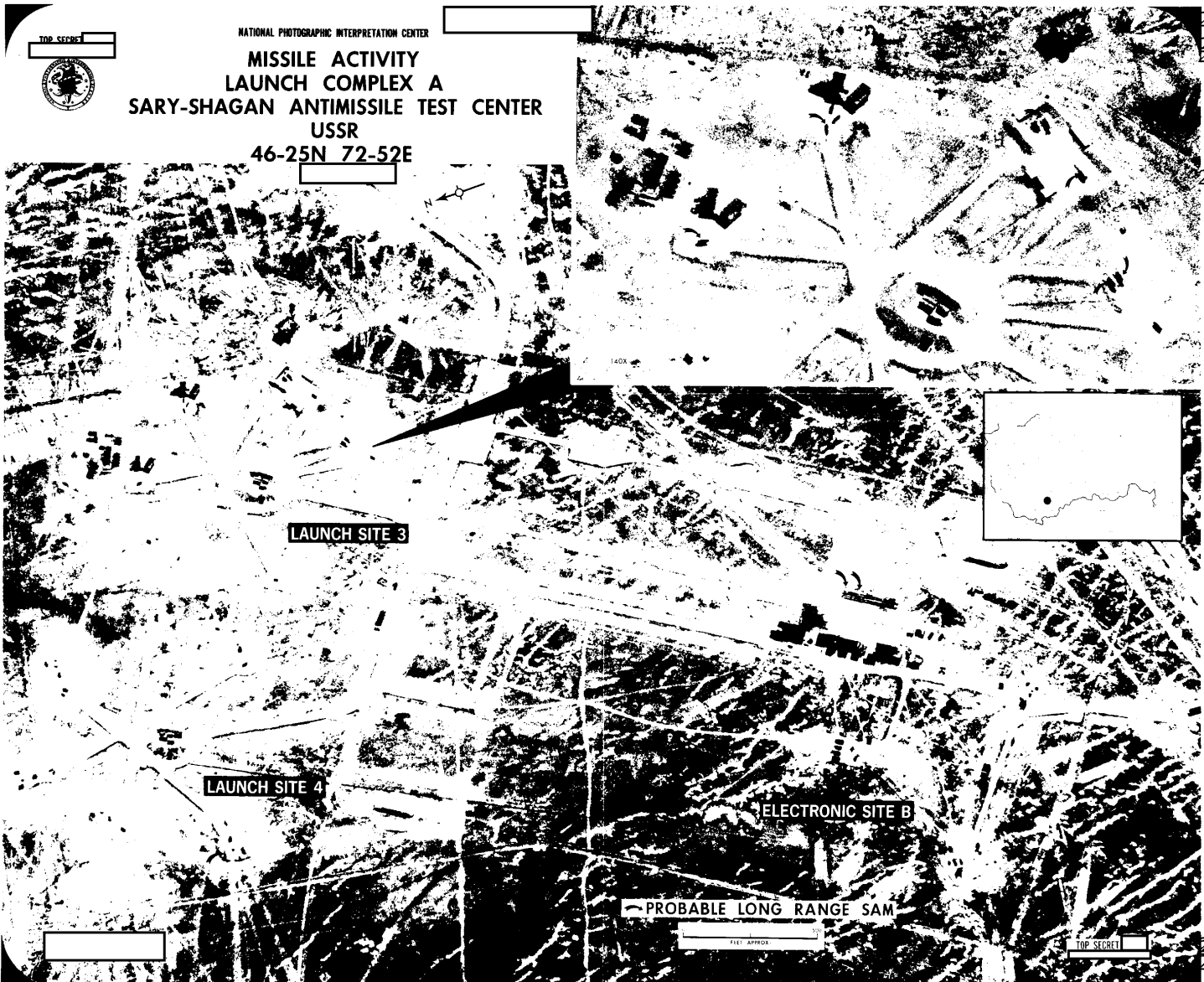
