9. MISSION READOUT: NO NUCLEAR STORAGE OBSERVED. NO CHANGES IN ASM STORAGE AREA. OB -- 3 BEAR, 2 BLINDER, 46 BADGER (5 ARE LOADED WITH PROBABLE KENNEL ASM's), 1 MAIL, 1 CAMEL, 1 CAT/CUB; 1 COKE, 1 CAB, 2 COLT, 1 HOOK, 2 POSS HARP AND 2 ADDITIONAL PROBABLE KENNEL (ONE IS POSITIONED IN FRONT OF THE WING OF A BADGER AND THE OTHER IS BEING TOWED DOWN THE TAXIWAY). EIGHT PROBABLE KENNEL (4 WITH FOLDED WINGS), 8 PROBABLE KENNEL FUSELAGES AND AND AT LEAST 16 PROBABLE KENNEL CRATES ARE OBSERVED IN THE ASM FACILITY.
