1. SIGNIFICANCE:

INDICATES EGYPTIAN ORDER OF BATTLE PRIOR TO THE EVACUATION.

2. LOCATION:

AT THE SOUTHERN END OF THE SHIBH JAZIRAT SINA (SINAI PENINSULA) ON THE RED SEA APPROACH TO THE STRAIT OF TIRAN AT 2750N - 03417E.

3. REMARKS:

SHARM ASH SHAYKH SERVED AS THE MAIN SUPPORT BASE FOR THE 1956 EGYPTIAN BLOCKADE OF THE GULF OF AQABA. FOLLOWING THE OUTBREAK OF THE SUEZ WAR AND THE CAPTURE OF SHARM ASH SHAYKH BY THE ISRAELI ARMY ON 5 NOV 56, THE INSTALLATION WAS TURNED OVER TO THE UN EMERGENCY FORCE. A UNIT OF THE UNEF OCCUPIED THE AREA UNTIL [Redacted] AT WHICH TIME IT WAS EVACUATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH EGYPT'S REQUESTED WITHDRAWAL OF THE UNEF ON 17 MAY 67.

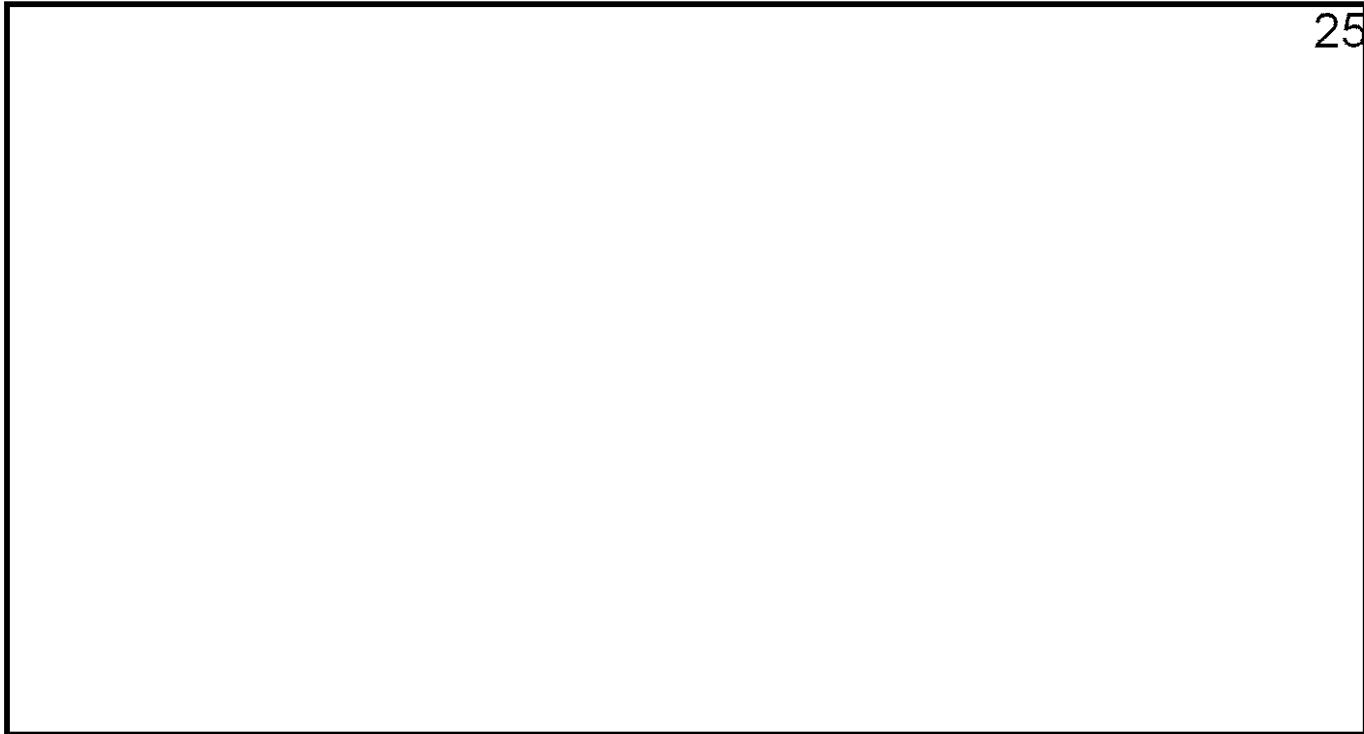

9. MISSION READOUT: BOTH RUNWAYS OF RAS UMM SID AIRFIELD HAVE BEEN DRIVEN OVER BY WHEELED/TRACKED VEHICLES.

AT RAS NASRANI COASTAL DEFENSE AREA (2800N - 03425E), A PROBABLE AA POSITION IS UNDER NETTING. NUMEROUS TRENCHING ACTIVITY IS OBSERVED IN THE AREA. (NOT ON GRAPHIC)

UNIDENTIFIED MILITARY ACTIVITY CONSISTING OF 7 VEHICLES AND POSSIBLE BIVOUAC/ DEFENSIVE POSITIONS BETWEEN 2754N - 03419E AND 2754N - 03418E. (NOT ON GRAPHIC)

A 6-GUN AA POSITION (POSSIBLY OCCUPIED) IS OBSERVED AT 2755N - 03422E. (NOT ON GRAPHIC)

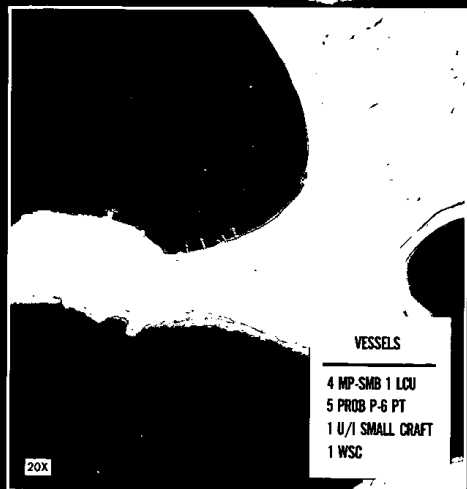
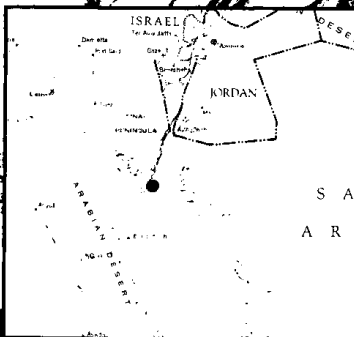
