1. SIGNIFICANCE:

THE DZUNGARIAN GATE AREA NEAR THE TOWN OF YUMIN, CHINA, IS THE SCENE OF THE REPORTED 13 AUGUST CLASH BETWEEN SOVIET AND CHINESE TROOPS.

2. LOCATION:

THE CENTER OF DZUNGARIAN GATE IS LOCATED AT
APPROXIMATELY 45-12N 082-35E. DRUZHBA ARMY
BARRACKS AL 1 IS 2 NM FROM THE BORDER AT 45-13-20N
082-29-10E. YUMIN IS IN SINKIANG PROVINCE, 1
NM EAST OF THE USSR CHINA BORDER AT 45-57-30N
082-32-00E, AND APPROXIMATELY 43 NM NORTH OF
DRUZHBA.

3. REMARKS:

THE DZUNGARIAN GATE IS AN HISTORIC ACCESS ROUTE
BETWEEN TURKESTAN AND CENTRAL ASIA. IT IS APPROXIMATELY 10 NM WIDE AND 40 NM IN LENGTH AND HAS A
GENERAL ELEVATION OF 1,500 FEET WITH THE MOUNTAINS
RISING TO OVER 7,000 FEET ON EITHER SIDE. DRUZBA
ARMY BARRACKS AL 1, THE ONLY SETTLEMENT IN THE GATE
AREA, IS ALSO THE TERMINMUS OF A RAIL LINE RUNNING
