The Monitoring Division establishes listening posts at strategic locations; systematically monitors, translates and reports on voice and Morse intelligence broadcasts of foreign transmitters; determines frequencies, schedules and behaviors of such transmitters as a source of intelligence; reports findings to the Editorial Division.




