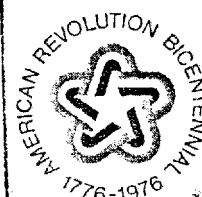

1. Sir, this memorandum responds to your request that you be kept advised of the nature and scope of activities engaged in by CIA Air Force reservists attached for training to the Directorate Intelligence Reserve Forces of the Air Force (AFIS/RE). In brief, our efforts thus far appear to have been most successful and rewarding to our CIA personnel, to the Air Force and to the Defense Intelligence Agency.

2. More specifically, [redacted] was officially activated as of 1 July 1975. Since then, and at any given time, some 59 officers and 1 Sergeant (all CIA employees) have been assigned to [redacted], making it the largest of the 39 reserve units attached to AFIS/RE.

3. [redacted] has almost completed its first training year. All personnel have met the mandatory requirement to attend six training weekends and all have either completed the annual requirement to perform a 2-week active duty tour or are scheduled for such a tour. Additional training weekends have been scheduled for July and September to enable a smooth transition into the new fiscal year schedule. The new fiscal year training cycle itself is scheduled to begin with a training weekend in October.
