3. MISSION READOUT:

UE 434F, 15 JUNE 1966, REVEALS FIVE BTR-40 ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIERS, EACH CARRYING DUAL 14.5 MM HEAVY ANTIAIRCRAFT MACHINEGUNS (ZPU-2), PARKED ON A ROAD WITH SMALL PERSONNEL TENTS PITCHED BETWEEN THE VEHICLES. FOUR OF THE FIVE ZPU-2 MACHINEGUNS ARE BEING FIRED AT THE RECONNAISSANCE AIRCRAFT.


