1. SIGNIFICANCE:

THIS BRIEFING BOARD DEPICTS THE ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIXTH SAM SITE IDENTIFIED IN NORTH VIETNAM, AND IS THE SOUTHERNMOST SITE.

2. LOCATION:

THE SITE IS LOCATED IN A HEAVILY WOODED AREA 12.1 NM SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF KY ANH AND APPROXIMATELY FIFTY-TWO NM NORTH OF THE DMZ.

3. REMARKS:

OF THE ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX SA-2 SAM SITES OBSERVED IN NORTH VIETNAM SINCE APRIL 1965, SEVEN HAVE BEEN ABANDONED AND TWO HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS ANTIAIRCRAFT ARTILLERY SITES, BRINGING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF KNOWN USABLE SITES TO ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN.

4. MISSION READOUT:

REVEALS THIS FIELD DEPLOYED SAM SITE

TO CONSIST OF SIX UNREVETTED LAUNCH POSITIONS, AN UNREVETTED CENTRAL

GUIDANCE AREA, AND THREE MISSILE HOLD POSITIONS. NO MISSILES OR MISSILE

ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT ARE NOTED WITHIN THE SITE. A POSSIBLE ACQUISITION

RADAR SITE IS LOCATED JUST SOUTHEAST OF THE SITE.

A VEHICLE PARK (WHICH HAS BEEN THE OBJECT OF AN AIR STRIKE)

LOCATED 0.6 NM TO THE NORTHWEST AT 17-53-19N 106-21-11E CONTAINS FIVE


