IN THE SOUTHEAST AREA OF VUNG HA LONG (BAY).

3. REMARKS:

THIS IS THE SECOND TANKER-TO-BARGE POL OFF-LOADING OPERATION
OBSERVED ON PHOTOGRAPHY IN THIS AREA SINCE BOMBING OF THE MAJOR
NORTH VIETNAMESE POL STORAGE FACILITIES BEGAN.

4. MISSION READOUT:

[REDACTED] REVEALS THE TANKER WITH FOUR POL
BARGES ALONGSIDE. FUELING HOSES ARE OBSERVED BETWEEN THE TANKER AND
TWO BARGES, AND CAMOUFLAGE NETTING IS APPARENT OVER THE FOUR BARGES.

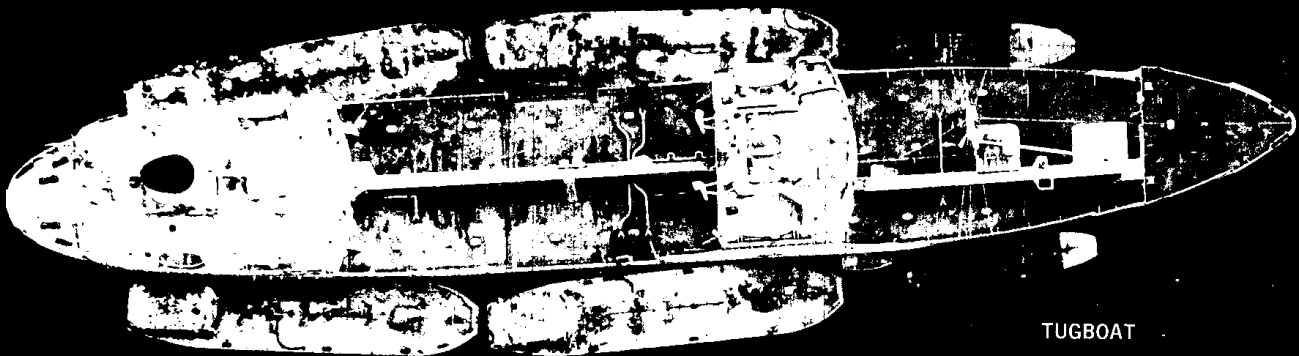
