HA NOI ARMY BARRACKS WEST TAY HO IS LOCATED TWO NM NORTHWEST OF
THE HA NOI RAILROAD CLASSIFICATION YARD AT UTM WJ843264.

3. BACKGROUND:

[REDACTED] REVEALED A BARRACKS AREA
CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY NINETY-NINE BUILDINGS, A STADIUM, A TRAINING
AREA, AND A PARADE GROUND.

A SEPARATE SECURED AREA WITH FOUR GUARD TOWERS WAS SHOWN TO
CONTAIN APPROXIMATELY THIRTY-NINE BUILDINGS. TWO UNDERGROUND BUNKERS
WERE OBSERVED UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN THIS AREA.

THIRTY-ONE CARGO TRUCKS, FIVE UTILITY TRUCKS, THIRTEEN MOBILE
GENERATORS, ONE CRANE, AND SIX UNIDENTIFIED VEHICLES WERE ALSO OBSERVED.

VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT: SIXTY-FOUR TRUCKS (INCLUDING AT LEAST EIGHT ELECTRONICS VANS), TEN FOUR-WHEEL TRAILERS, FOUR PILE DRIVERS/DRILLING RIGS, THREE TRUCK MOUNTED CRANES, THREE GAZ-69'S, ONE TANK TRUCK, ONE FARM TRACTOR, ONE BUS, ONE CAR, AND ONE LOWBOY TRAILER. ALSO OBSERVED ARE SIX 37MM ANTI-AIRCRAFT ARTILLERY PIECES PARKED ADJACENT TO THE ATHLETIC FIELD, AND FOUR 57MM AAA PIECES IN A REVERTED EIGHT-GUN SITE. (NOT ALL SHOWN ON GRAPHIC.)

FACILITIES IDENTIFIED WITHIN THE AREA INCLUDE NUMEROUS BARRACK BUILDINGS, A VEHICLE MAINTENANCE AREA, AND AN OPEN STORAGE AREA CONTAINING PIPES AND POLES. ALSO OBSERVED WAS AN ATHLETIC FIELD, A POSSIBLE OBSTACLE COURSE, AND A PROBABLE TRAINING AREA FOR HORSES.
