THE SITE IS LOCATED 14.7 NM WEST-NORTHWEST OF VINH AT UTM WF456729.

#### 3. MISSION READOUT:

CONSIST OF FOUR UNREVETTED LAUNCH POSITIONS AND A
PARTIALLY REVETTED CENTRAL GUIDANCE AREA. NO MISSILES
OR MISSILE ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT ARE OBSERVED.

THE SITE HAS BEEN SUBJECTED TO AN AIR STRIKE AND THE CENTRAL GUIDANCE AREA IS HEAVILY CRATERED. THE LAUNCH POSITIONS, HOWEVER, APPEAR INTACT AND USEABLE.


