1. SIGNIFICANCE:

THIS BRIEFING BOARD DEPICTS BALLOON ACTIVITY IN THE VICINITY OF X. THUONG VILLAGE.

2. LOCATION:

X. THUONG LIES AT UTM WH914785, 4.5 NM NORTH-NORTHWEST OF PHU LY AND APPROXIMATELY FIFTY MILES SOUTHWEST OF HAI PHONG.

3. COLLATERAL:

COLLATERAL HAS REPORTED SEVERAL BALLOON SIGHTINGS DURING THE PAST SEVERAL MONTHS. THE FIRST SUCH REPORT CONCERNED TWENTY-FIVE TETHERED BALLOONS APPROXIMATELY EIGHTEEN MILES NORTHEAST OF HAI PHONG ON 5 AUGUST. THEY APPEARED TO BE ABOUT TWELVE FEET IN DIAMETER AND TETHERED 3,000 FEET ABOVE SEA LEVEL. SUBSEQUENT SIGHTINGS HAVE REPORTED FROM FOUR TO FIFTY BALLOONS OF VARIOUS COLORS TETHERED AT NUMEROUS ALTITUDES RANGING FROM 1,500 TO 3,800 FEET, AND RANGING IN SIZE FROM FOUR TO TWELVE FEET. MOST SIGHTINGS HAVE INVOLVED THE GENERAL AREA APPROXIMATELY EIGHTEEN MILES NORTHEAST OF HAI PHONG. ESTIMATES OF THE PURPOSE OF SUCH DEPLOYMENTS INCLUDE:

- A. DENIAL OF LOW LEVEL ACCESS TO SPECIFIC AREAS
- B. FORCING FLIGHTS OF ENEMY AIRCRAFT TO USE HIGHER FLIGHT LEVELS
