3. MISSION READOUT:

[REDACTED] REVEALS A CABLE SUSPENSION BRIDGE,  
APPROXIMATELY 620 FEET LONG, WHICH HAS BEEN RECONSTRUCTED AND APPEARS  
TO BE SERVICEABLE. THE BRIDGE, HEAVILY DAMAGED BY AN AIR STRIKE ON  
19 JANUARY 1967, CONSISTS OF CABLE SUSPENSION TOWERS ON EACH RIVER  
BANK, TWO HEAVY OVERHEAD SUSPENSION CABLES, AND FOUR DECK CABLES  
FLUSH WITH THE APPROACHES. AS A SERVICEABILITY DECEPTION TECHNIQUE  
AND FOR EASY REASSEMBLY, THE DECKING HAS BEEN STACKED INTERMITTENTLY  
ON THE DECK CABLES.

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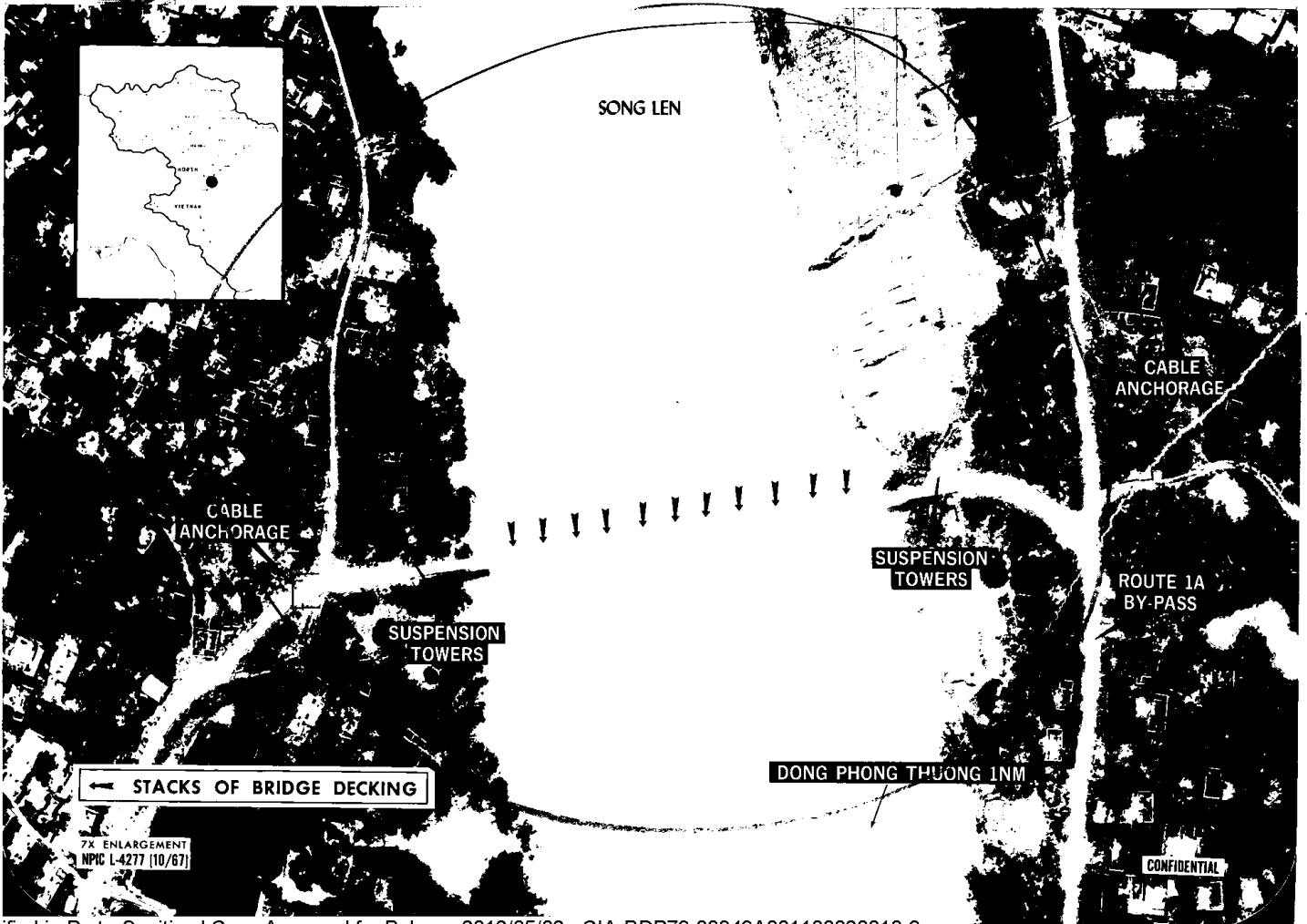
