THIS BRIEFING BOARD DEPICTS THE TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHTH SA-2 MISSILE SITE TO BE IDENTIFIED IN NORTH VIETNAM.

2. LOCATION:

THE SITE IS LOCATED 1.2 NM NORTHWEST OF VINH AT UTM WF699654.

3. MISSION READOUT:

25X1 [REDACTED] REVEALS THE SITE TO CONSIST OF FOUR PARTIALLY REVETTED LAUNCH POSITIONS OCCUPIED BY MISSILES ON LAUNCHERS AND AN OCCUPIED, UNREVETTED GUIDANCE AREA. A GUIDANCE RADAR AND AT LEAST FOUR VANS ARE OBSERVED IN THE GUIDANCE AREA.
