IN THE USE OF TRUCKS TO MOVE SUPPLIES SOUTHWARD. AS MANY AS FIVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY TRUCKS WERE OBSERVED ON ROUTE LA BETWEEN THANH HOA AND DONG HOI. AN ADDITIONAL TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY TO THREE HUNDRED TRUCKS WERE SIGHTED DURING AND AFTER THE TRUCE. AT LEAST SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY OF THE COMBINED TOTAL WERE HEADING SOUTH IN "BUMPER-TO-BUMPER" TRAFFIC ON THE ROAD BETWEEN THANH HOA AND VINH DURING THE CEASE FIRE. A MILE-LONG, FIFTY-FIVE TRUCK CONVOY WAS SEEN NORTH OF VINH AND APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY TRUCKS WERE SEEN NEAR THE QUANG KHE FERRIES NORTH OF DONG HOI WHERE ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY SAMPANS CARRIED SUPPLIES ACROSS THE SONG GIANG (RIVER).

ASSUMING THAT EACH OF THE SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY TRUCKS OBSERVED TRAVELLING SOUTH DURING AND JUST AFTER THE TRUCE CARRIED THREE TONS OF CARGO,

UP TO 2,250 TONS OF MATERIAL WOULD HAVE BEEN MOVED DURING THE PERIOD. IF

THE TONNAGE WERE DELIVERED TO SOUTH VIETNAM, IT WOULD BE EQUIVALENT TO

APPROXIMATELY A NINETY-DAY SUPPLY OF THE ESTIMATED EXTERNAL REQUIREMENTS

PROVIDED BY NORTH VIETNAM TO VIET CONG AND NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY FORCES IN
SOUTH VIETNAM.

WATER-BORNE LOGISTIC CRAFT ACTIVITY WAS NOT SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASED DURING
THE TRUCE PROBABLY BECAUSE THERE WAS INSUFFICIENT TIME TO EMPLOY THESE CRAFT.
