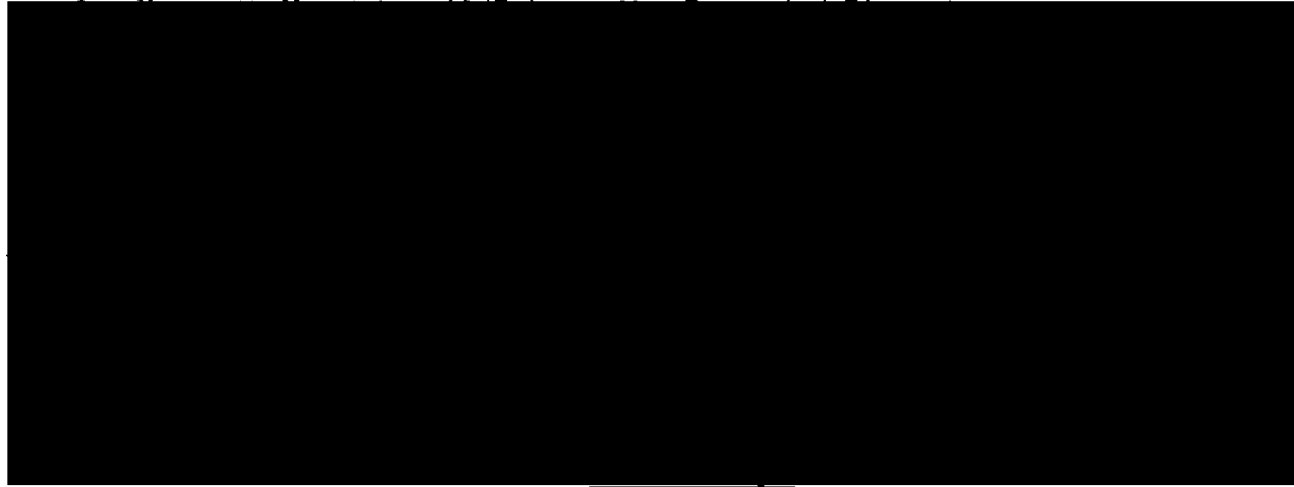

25X1A5a1 1. [redacted] (O/IC) raised the question of whether it was appropriate for [redacted] to print additional copies of the Vulnerability Studies. I advised that it was dependent upon whether our Printing and Reduction plant was in a position to do the job. It was agreed that we would await securing the details of the proposal from [redacted] who will be in town from [redacted] the early part of next week. 25X1A5a1

25X1A9a 2. [redacted] (Spec. Asst. to DD/A) in charge of the program for development of CIA regulations called to request I represent the DD/I on the Steering Committee which has been established to provide guidance in connection with the program. It was agreed that we would defer designation of a DD/I alternate until we had a better understanding of the requirements that would be placed upon the DD/I area. It may be desirable in connection with the development of portions of the regulations which will be the responsibility of DD/I offices to have an alternate designated from O/IC.
