Friday, 21 November 1952

1. At the Director's morning meeting, Wisner and Dulles raised for discussion the inadequacy of our actions to combat Communism in darkest Africa. D/CI indicated the desirability of having a Special Estimate within a reasonable time to cover the situation there with particular reference to Communist infiltration of native movements such as the Mau-Mau. After the meeting, I asked [redacted] to survey what we had concerning Africa and what more was needed to complete an intelligence picture on the Continent.

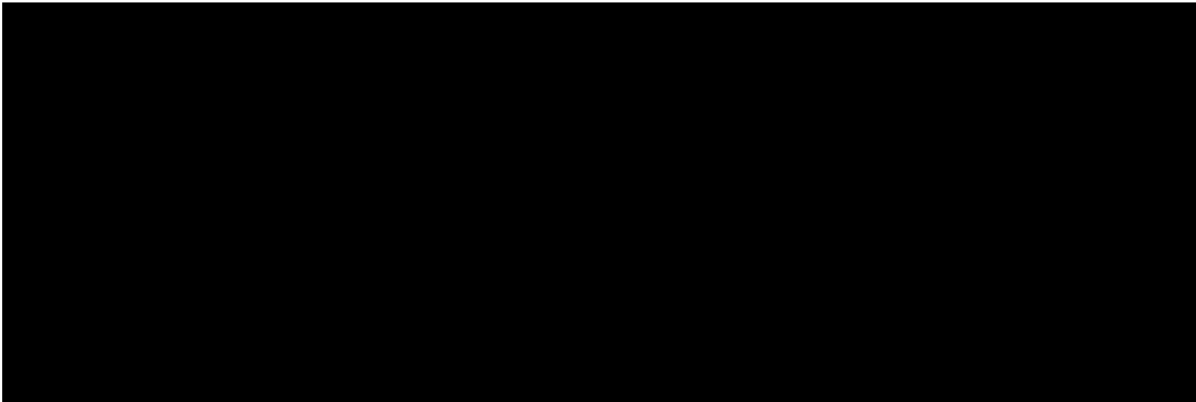

After the meeting, talked briefly with Wisner and [redacted] regarding the handling of DD/I personnel, now manning [redacted] or shortly to be shipped thereto, in the event that [redacted] was curtailed or eliminated in the course of reducing the [redacted]. Both emphatically agreed that these people were the property of the DD/I Offices whence they came and that they would not be reassigned from the [redacted] except to their former offices.
