## MINUTES OF THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA STAFF MEETING, 28 MARCH 1955

25X1A9a read aloud from a recent D/GL memorandum, a guide for selection of Soviet maps. The group discussed the criteria presented 25X1A9a in the memorandum. Said that the memorandum is now being revised, and it was agreed that the revisions he recommended were satisfactory 25X1A9a 25X1A2g Mr. memorandum concerning proposed symbol for projects was discussed, and it was decided that an attempt should be made to handle the problem by statements of priority through the chain of command up to the AD level, without use of a symbol. commented that the data concerning man-hour and 25X1A9a salary costs in connection with the Clark Committee survey should be in two categories -- Preparation and Presentation. The total figures should be expressed in man-hours and average grade level or average hourly pay. 25X1A9a commented that the Far Eastern Association meetings, at the Washington Hotel from 29 to 31 March 1955, should be of interest to a number of people in the Geographic Area. The Economic Area is recruiting at these meetings and D/GS should also 25X1A9a contact appropriate individuals. ...... reported that Mr. Amory has recently emphasized the increasing need for Far Bastern Intelligence Officers and the increasing intelligence progrem on the Far East. commented that if registration fees are required at such 25X1A9a meetings it should be possible to get reimbursement for those individuals selected by the Geographic Area. 5. Individuals flying to the AAG meetings at Mamphis, Tennessee will probably not be able to travel in groups larger than 2 per plane. 6. A briefing of 00/C field personnel is scheduled for 4 April 1955 25X1A9a from 10:35 to 11:10 A.M. will handle this briefing. 00/C would like to schedule such briefings three times a year, bringing in different groups from the field.

The recommendation proposes that the organization should be on the basis of significant problems rather than on functional fields such as physical geography, bio-geography, teaching of geography, etc.

reported a request from the Air Force for recommendations regarding native personnel to be used by the Air Force in establishing stations between Taiwan and Africa, in connection with the Air Force's Second Annualar Eclipse Expedition. The group discussed the possibilities of sending Geographic Area personnel to work with this expedition; there is some doubt as to the amount of useful area knowledge to be gained from such experience.
