1. Op-16-1-F has referred the attached memorandum from Captain Babbitt to Op-16-P.
2. After studying the basic memo, the purport seems to be:

(a) That P-3 is busily engaged upon requests of ComAmphibious Force forwarded by Cominch, which may be construed as intradepartmental studies. Therefore, that they do not conflict with any plan of G-2 and ONI for collaboration on future publications which may be determined upon by the joint ONI, MIS, OSS steering committee now sitting.

(b) Enclosures (A) and (C) are recommendations as to the scope and format of future interservice monographs (priority and distribution also problems for the joint committee are not considered).

(c) Recommendation for ^①expediting the work now in hand in P-3 and calling upon MIS and OSS to publish certain parallel studies simultaneously. I concur in first recommendation; suggest second recommendation, together with Enclosures (A) and (C), be referred to interservice committee now in session.
