#### INCIDENCE OF NEW THREATS OF TERRORIST ACTIVITY IN WEEKLY SITUATION REPORTS—1974

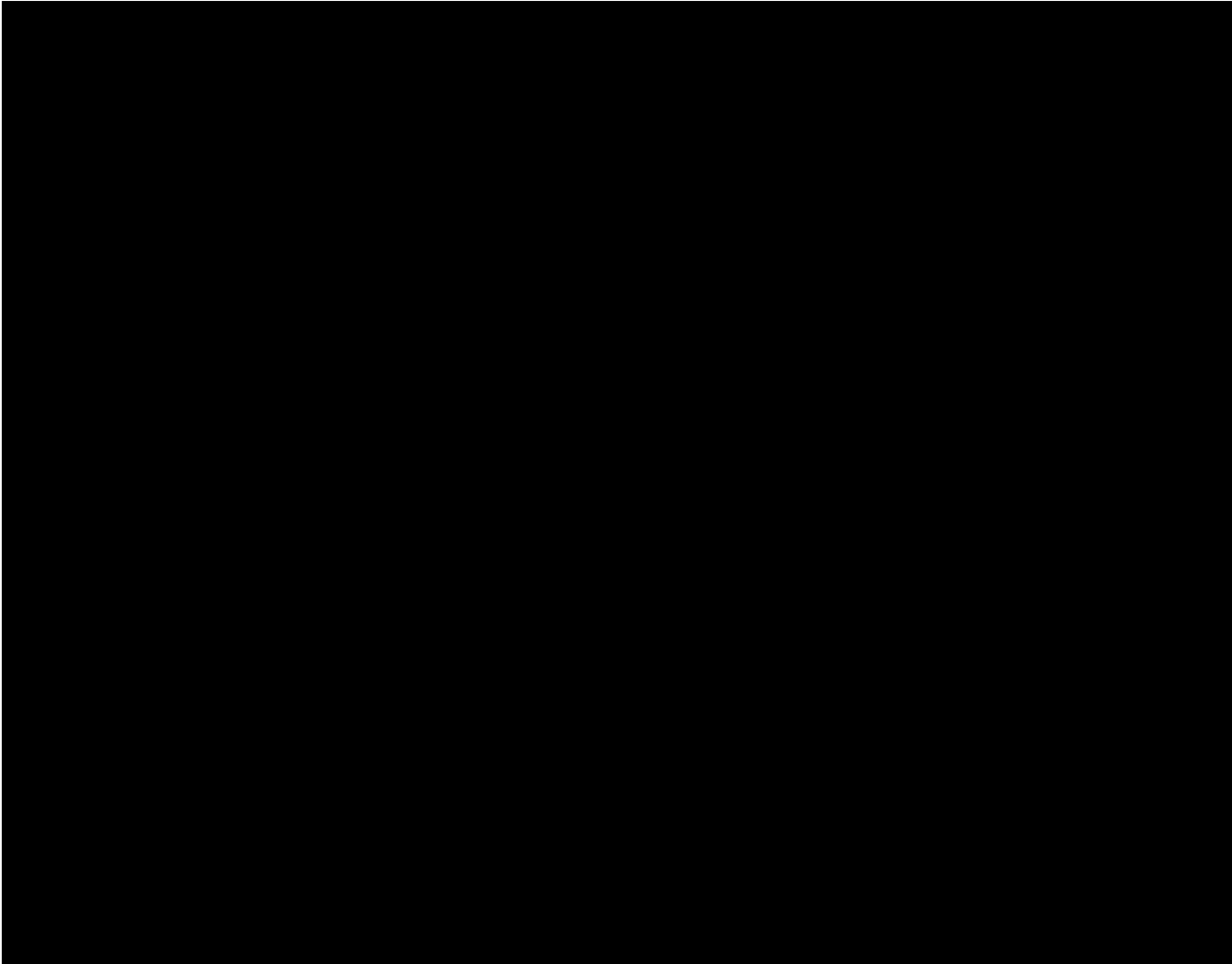

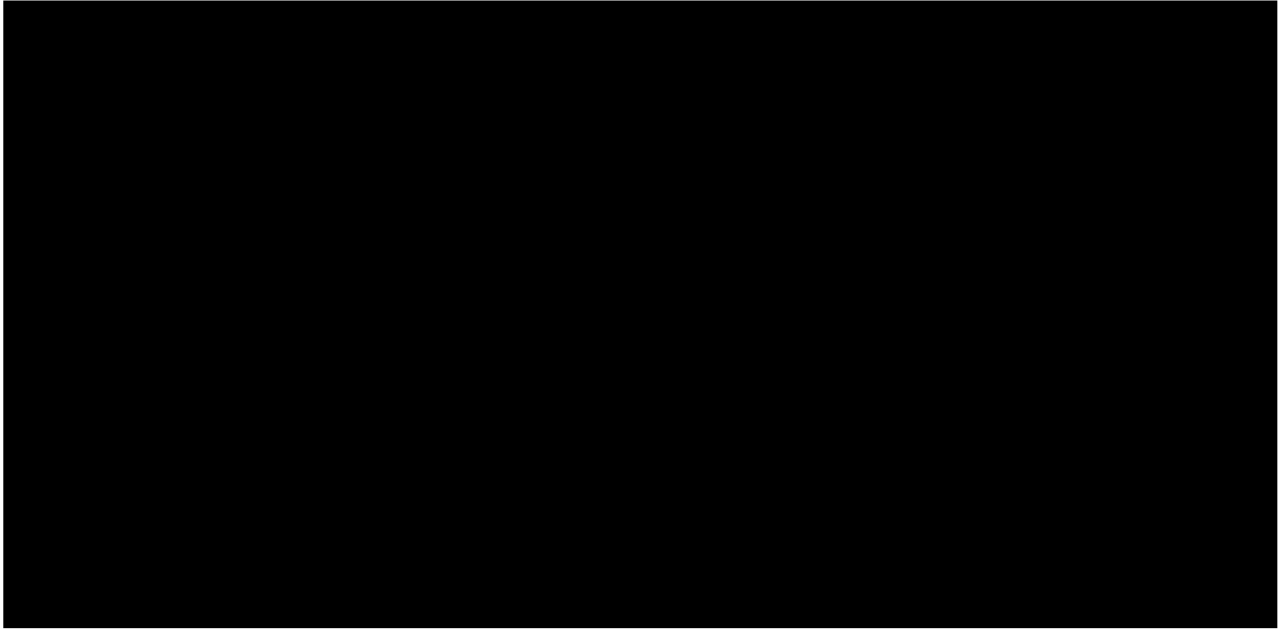
Deranged Iranian Responsible for BA Hijacking in London

The hijacking of a British Airways (BA) plane in London on 7 January was perpetrated by an unemployed 29-year-old Iranian, Saed Madjid, described as mentally unbalanced, who had acted entirely on his own in the operation with no apparent political motivation. (See the 7 January issue.) After negotiations on the ground at London's Heathrow Airport, the hijacker was given the ransom and parachute he demanded, and the plane took off, ostensibly for Paris. The plane circled for two hours, however, and landed at Stansted Airfield near London. The hijacker, realizing he had been tricked, attempted to run away but was quickly caught by the police. The gun he carried turned out to be plastic and the grenade was a piece of wood. The hijacker was charged in court and remanded in custody for a hearing on 16 January.

During the hijacking British authorities became concerned by the full media exposure of the negotiations and the simulated flight to France while they were still in progress. They also were disturbed because the hijacker was able to board with his toy gun, and BA immediately announced it will now

Two U.S. Hijackers Arrested by French

On 24 January French police arrested two U.S. citizens who hijacked a Western Airlines Boeing 727 out of Los Angeles on 2 June 1972 and then continued to Algiers on another jetliner with a ransom of \$500,000. The French stated that the man and woman were arrested outside their apartment in Paris and were carrying passports with false names. The FBI has identified the man as a self-proclaimed member of the Black Panthers. The Justice Department has requested that the couple be extradited to the U.S. (UNCLASSIFIED)

U.S. Tourists Interrogated and Beaten by Palestinians in Beirut

On 31 December 1974 three U.S. tourists visiting Beirut were picked up, interrogated and beaten by Palestinian soldiers, according to their tour guide. The three tourists had taken a taxi in downtown Beirut at about 7 p.m. to return to their hotel, but became lost and ended up in a barricaded area inhabited by Palestinians, in front of what was thought to be the headquarters of a Palestinian organization. The soldiers stopped them and asked for their passports. They were then told to go into the building but refused, which caused the soldiers to start shooting in the air. The tourists were taken upstairs and for about five hours were interrogated and beaten. They were asked whether they worked for the American military, what they were doing in Lebanon, and who was their tour guide. Before releasing them, the Palestinians told the tourists they were concerned about the possibility of an attack by Israeli commandos. Two of the tourists were sure their hotel room had been searched while they were being interrogated. A U.S. Embassy officer told the tour guide this was about the 15th such incident reported in three weeks. (UNCLASSIFIED)

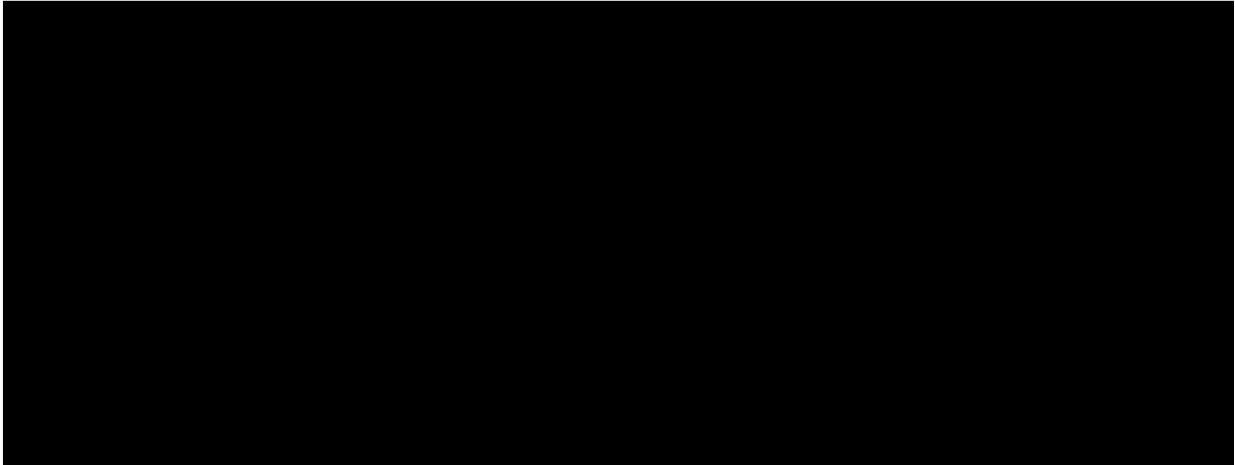
