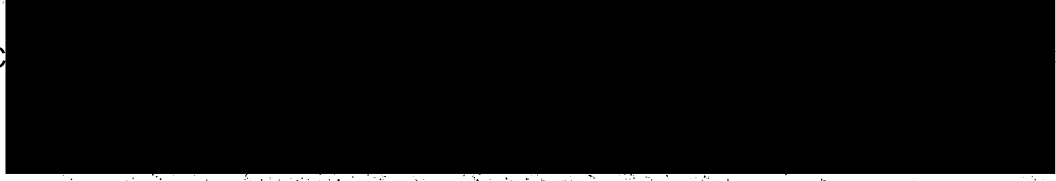

This memorandum requests approval for the acquisition of a Honeywell B-716 computer, a disc file, two cathode ray tube (CRT) input/output (I/O) devices and associated peripherals which will be used to expand and modernize the Office of Communications, Special Programs Division's existing computer managed cryptographic analysis and processing capability.
