MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Support Services Staff, DD/S

SUBJECT : Reporting Status of UNIVAC Equipment

1. The following information is provided in response to [redacted] informal request that the UNIVAC equipment in the Headquarters Building sixth floor DATACOM Unit be added to the ADP MIS inventory. It is understood that [redacted] is of the opinion that this equipment should be reported in the periodic ADP submissions now required of ADP Unit 0402.

2. The UNIVAC equipment now located in the DATACOM Unit includes two 9300's and two 100's. The UNIVAC 100's will be released by OC within a six months period, leaving the two 9300's. In addition, OC will obtain an addi-

3. The two UNIVAC 9300's and 100's are being utilized on a lease/purchase arrangement with the manufacturer at a total cost in FY-1969 of \$204,888.00. Additionally, the DATACOM Unit has two IBM card punchers, an IBM 026 at \$60 per month (paid for by the Office of Computer Services) and an IBM 029 at \$69 per month (paid for by the Office of Communications).

4. Until 1 July 1968, the personnel and facilities of the sixth floor DATACOM Unit were assigned to DD/S&T/OSA. It is understood that the ADP equipment in the sixth floor DATACOM Unit was never reported by the DD/S&T for ADP MIS inventory purposes because of the extreme sensitivity of the projects to which the equipment is dedicated. When OC assumed control of the DATACOM Unit, the same security practice was continued and transcript sheets on the equipment were not prepared. Prior to adding the UNIVAC equipment to the MIS inventory, it is requested that you query the DD/S&T (the project controlling office) to determine if the current practice of not reporting the UNIVAC equipment should be continued or changed. We shall withhold from submitting the MIS Format Transcript Sheets changing the Unit 0402 inventory until you can advise us whether or not to proceed.
