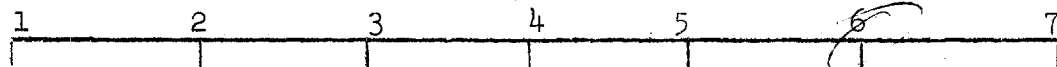
Evaluation

The objective of the course is to update Deputy Director for Administration careerists' knowledge and understanding of current activities, problems and trends in the Directorate and its various offices.

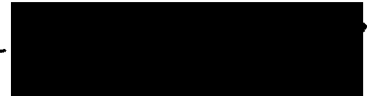
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- A. Please indicate on this numerical scale how well in your estimation, the course has met its objective. (Number 1 is the lowest, number 7 is the highest.)
