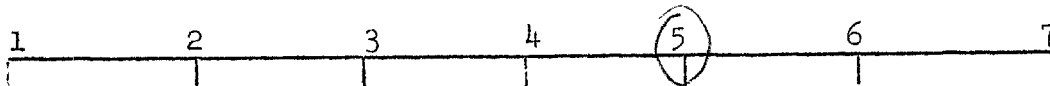
Evaluation
